


Please stop disposing of items illegally or we will be forced to recharge you.

Bags we remove from in front of your property or any communal area

Charge: £12.00 including VAT for each bag

If you are seen disposing of any bulky items, we will charge you for removing and disposing of them

Charge: £42.00 per item including VAT and administration costs.

- All other items seen in any communal area will be removed within 24 hours after a letter has been issued to the owner of the item.
- The owner will have to pay £12.00 per item.
   To reclaim them you will need proof of I.D to confirm who you are and ownership of the item(s).
- Items will be disposed of after being stored for 28 days
