ABOUT JANAKPUR DHAM

According to tradition and archaaelogical ividence found at the site ancient civilization indicates Janakpur Dham as the Capital of the Vidaha dynesty that ruled to Mithila region in ancient times. Janakpur is located about 225 km. southeast of Kathmandu. As of 2021, the city hed a population of 195,438 and density 2125/km². Janakpur is currently the fourth most populated city of Nepal.

Najakpur is located about 23 km away from the

Bhithamore of Bharat. Nepal railways operates between Janakpur and Jainagar to Bharat. The earliest description of Janakpur as a pilgrimage site dates to 1805. Earlier archaelogical evidence of the presence of an ancient city has not been found. King Janak's palace is thought to have been located in ancient Janakpur as it is believed to be the capital of the Videhas. According to Ramayan, he found a baby girl in a furrow, named her Sita, and raised her as his daughter. When, was older, he offered her in marriege to anyone who was able to lift the bow of Shiva, left near Janakpur a thousand years earlier. Many Royal suiter tried but only Rama, the Prince of Ayodhya, could lift the bow. According to an old song, this bow was found northeast of Janakpur. Now Janakpur expanded into a commercial center and became capital of the Dhanusa district in the 1960.

How to reach Janakpurdham:- Janakpurdham is a city of Nepal which is 45 km from Sitamarhi. You can resch Sitamarhi by train. It is 23 km from Bhithamore. If you want to travel by air then you fly from any town of Bhara to Patna then you can travel from Patna to Sitamarhi either by Bus or by Car.
