APPARATUS JUDGING CATEGORIES

PUMPER

Best equipped Pumper **1500 GPM and over** from a fire department Not Affiliated with a city or town.

Best equipped Pumper **1500 GPM and over** from a fire department Affiliated with a city or town.

Best equipped Pumper **750-1250 GPM** from a fire department Not Affiliated with a city or town.

Best equipped Pumper **750-1250 GPM** from a fire department Affiliated with a city or town.

****Pumpers shall have no capabilities of a jet/quick dump system****

PUMPER TANKER

Best equipped **Pumper/Tanker** with a class A pump of 750 GPM or more, a water tank of not less than 1000 gallons and a Quick Dump System, from a fire department Not Affiliated with a city or town.

Best equipped **Pumper/Tanker** with a class A pump of 750 GPM or more, a water tank of not less than 1000 gallons and a Quick Dump System, from a fire department Affiliated with a city or town.

TANKER

Best equipped Tanker having a pump, and a water tank of not less than 1200 gallons and a Quick Dump System, from a fire department Not Affiliated with a city or town.

Best equipped Tanker having a pump, and a water tank of not less than 1200 gallons and a Quick Dump System, from a fire department Affiliated with a city or town.

MINI-PUMPER

Best equipped Mini-Pumper being any truck with a compartmentalized body, a minimum pump capacity ranging from 250GPM to 750 GPM @ 150PSI. Pump will be powered from the chassis engine by way of either a pto auxiliary or a "split-shaft" primary drive. Water tank capacity will be a minimum of 200 gallons and a maximum of 400 gallons. Chassis not to exceed 19,500# GVW and can be either 2 or 4 wheel drive. Apparatus will be from a fire department Not Affiliated with a city or town.

Best equipped Mini-Pumper being any truck with a compartmentalized body, a minimum pump capacity ranging from 250GPM to 750 GPM @ 150PSI. Pump will be powered from the chassis engine by way of either a pto auxiliary or a "split-shaft" primary drive. Water tank capacity will be a minimum of 200 gallons and a maximum of 400 gallons. Chassis not to exceed 19,500# GVW and can be either 2 or 4 wheel drive. Apparatus will be from a fire department Affiliated with a city or town.

BRUSH TRUCK PICK UP STYLE

Best equipped Brush Truck being a 4 wheel drive pickup style unit having a maximum tank size of 250 Gallons and an auxiliary powered pump not to exceed 300 GPM, from a fire department Not Affiliated with a city or town.

BRUSH TRUCK COMPARTMENT STYLE OR FLAT BED

Best equipped Brush Truck being a 4 wheel drive compartment style body or a flatbed style with a minimum tank size of 250 Gallons and an auxiliary powered pump with a minimum rating of 200 GPM from a fire department **Not Affiliated** with a city or town.

RESCUE APPARATUS

Best equipped special service apparatus having no pump or water tank onboard with capabilities of carrying vast amounts of equipment for fire service and rescue related operations having no patient compartment **Not Affiliated** with a city or town.

AERIAL APPARATUS

Best equipped fire apparatus having no requirements of a pump or water tank with a permanently mounted power operated elevating device **Not Affiliated** with a city or town.

Best equipped fire apparatus having no requirements of a pump or water tank with a permanently mounted power operated elevating device **Affiliated** with a city or town.
