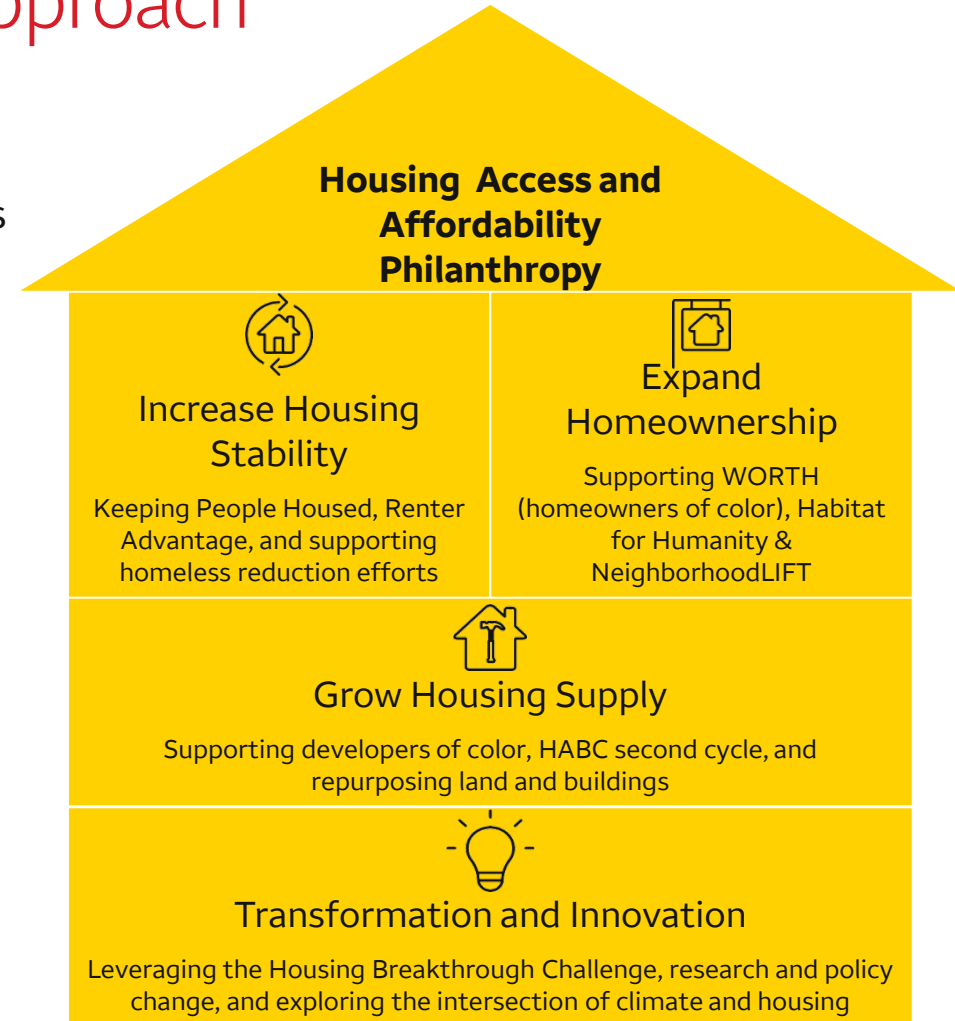
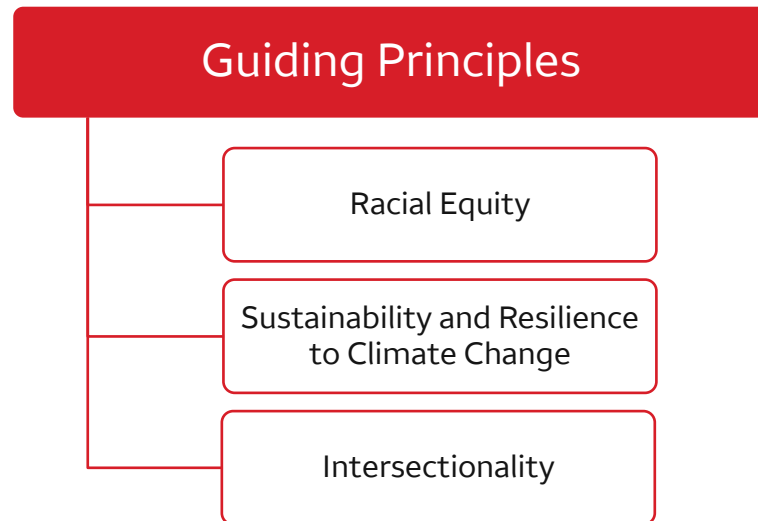
3) Small Business Growth
