## No-smoking Policy

### Promoting health and hygiene

#### Policy statement

Children's health and wellbeing is of the utmost importance for the children in our care. Smoking has proved to be a health risk and therefore in accordance with health & safety legislation and the Statutory Requirements of the EYFS (2025), the preschool operates a strict no smoking policy within its buildings and grounds.

#### Procedures

- The primary school grounds operate a no smoking site
- All staff, parents and volunteers are made aware of our no-smoking policy.
- We display no-smoking signs.
- Staff who smoke/vape may only do so during their agreed lunch break and not in areas where the children will be
- All new and prospective employees to be advised of the restrictions and rules regarding smoking at work through advertising material, the interview process and induction.
