



K Fellfarers Club Rules and some Club 'expectations':

General:

1. Membership of K Fellfarers is open to adults of 18 years of age and over who understand and support the Objectives of the Club (see page 1).
2. Children and young people under the age of 18 are welcome at High House and at appropriate Club events, but are at all times the responsibility of their parents or guardians and must be accompanied by at least one parent, guardian, or a nominated adult.
3. Subscriptions fall due on 1st January and must be paid by that date. Late payment will result in the requirement to re-apply for membership. *In practice the Treasurer will sometimes allow a 2-week extension to the deadline.*
4. The Committee will only consider new applications for membership when the applicant has met all of the relevant requirements of the Constitution.
5. Two working weekends are held each year at High House and members are expected to contribute to the maintenance and improvement work to the best of their abilities.
6. The Committee may suspend or withdraw the membership of any member.

At High House:

1. All visitors, including Members, must sign the Visitors Book on every visit to High House.
2. All visitors, including Members, must follow the 'When you arrive', 'While you're here', and 'When you leave' procedures listed on the 'Visitors to High House' sheet on the notice board in the Common Room.
3. Users behaviour should give due consideration to other users. All noise must be kept to a minimum after 11.00 pm if people are sleeping upstairs.
4. Pets are not allowed to sleep in the building and are not allowed in any room but the Common Room.
5. Each Member may take up to 2 Guests to stay at High House. A Guest Night Fee of £5.00 per person per night must be paid. It is the responsibility of Members to ensure that their Guests sign the Visitors' Book and that Guest Night Fees are collected and passed to the Treasurer (Val Calder).
6. Children (up to 18 years of age) of Members are not considered to be Guests and may stay at High House without charge.
7. Children (other than those of Members) between 5 and 17 years of age (inclusive) are considered to be Guests and must pay the full Guest Night Fee of £5.00
8. Children (other than those of Members) under 5 years of age are considered to be Guests but may stay at High House without charge.
9. Men and women must use their respective named dormitories, washing and toilet facilities (Ladies upstairs and Men downstairs). If circumstances require a mixed-gender sleeping arrangements (families with small children using the Members' Room for example) they must be agreed in advance by all people staying in the hut. In such circumstances men must at all times use the downstairs washroom and toilet.
10. Members and their guests may use High House at any time but discretion must be exercised when thinking of using High House if an external club has made a booking (see page 1). If sharing with an external club, Members must sleep in the Members' Room and must behave with discretion and courtesy.
11. The Committee may exclude children and/or guests for specific Club weekends if it feels such action is necessary.
