Public Notice to Office of the Attorney General Raul R. Labrador of Idaho

**Re: Request for Immediate Review of Criminal Referral
Beyond Pro and Bryce Baker**

Raul,

Please accept this letter as my formal request to the Idaho Attorney General's Office immediately launch a criminal investigation into the overwhelming evidence produced by the Causational Journalism series *Stroking Fiber*. The criminal enterprise involving *Beyond Pro*, its owner Bryce Baker, and two other executives Lucas Borough and Lane Ritchie, Ph.D.

This is a nationwide Human Capital Ponzi scheme. After Aaron Sobrio's thorough documentation of a \$300,000 swindle in episode 7.0, and Nextlink of Texas's seemingly criminal behavior in helping Bryce continue to operate is also extremely problematic in my opinion.

It's not just Aaron giving CEO Bill Baker direct and convincing data and awareness, but that Nextlink as a company with all relevant executives decided to trade legal operations for collusion with the organized

crime ring, evidenced by Larry Walker's \$28,000 in stolen deals subsequent to Sobrio's detailed emails.

There's also a massive legal problem with NYSE TDS Telecom and their month long coverup. Whether there's criminal implications there too sir, might be an opportunity for your office to collaborate with Kash Patel, FBI and DOJ.

Candidly Raul, this is whopper. Good news is you're a reasonable guy and won't play politics, knowing your office is obligated to get Bryce in handcuffs quickly as possible.

I submit this referral not as a political exercise, but as a Causational Journalist whose primary concern is the protection of the public. My work is rooted in a linear pipe of transparency. The investigative model that seeks systemic change, and to identify the underlying flaws that produce harm. Clip Artist Films mission has always been simple: EXPOSING ANY BUSINESS OR GOVERNMENT HURTING WE THE PEOPLE

So far over the course of Stroking Fiber, I have interviewed numerous individuals, reviewed business records and communications, and documented accounts from sales representatives, contractors, and other witnesses who have come forward voluntarily. As the investigation became public, additional individuals contacted me independently with information they believed was relevant.

After conducting extensive legal research and carefully considering my ethical responsibilities as a journalist, I have concluded that the most appropriate course is not to submit the entirety of my investigative file to your office at this time. I believe it is important that any criminal investigation remain wholly independent of my reporting and that investigators reach their own conclusions based upon evidence they collect themselves.

Accordingly, I am instead providing contact information for individuals who have represented themselves as victims or witnesses and who have indicated a willingness to speak with law enforcement. I believe this approach best preserves the independence of both the criminal justice process and the press while avoiding any suggestion that investigators relied upon a journalist's conclusions rather than conducting their own.

I have intentionally structured this referral so that the investigative process and the journalistic process remain separate. I believe maintaining that separation best serves the interests of justice, due process, and the public.

If investigators later determine that additional materials from my reporting would be beneficial, I am willing to discuss those requests at the appropriate time and in a manner consistent with journalistic ethics and applicable law.

Thank you for your attention to this referral, and seeing that the hard working proletariat classes building profit for capitalism gone wild receive the protection they deserve under the law.
