



Sometimes clients want to **FOLLOW** you, the therapist, to another place of employment. That is **A-OKAY**.

However,

Please know, you should follow basic ethical guidelines.

These guidelines will prevent you from getting into trouble, especially if you are referring clients for therapy, from your other place of employment.



Always make sure that it is the **CLIENT'S DECISION**, whether to stay at their current provider, or go somewhere else.

NEVER say to them "I am changing to this company, so you must come with me".

Always give the client a choice, to stay where they are now, or to go somewhere else. And yes, you can tell them where you are going to be working at.... but always make sure that the client has the choice of what to do.
