

Different forms of Art media

Visual Arts (2D & Traditional)

- **Drawing (Dry Media):** Graphite, charcoal, soft pastels, oil pastels, crayons, and coloured pencils.
- **Painting (Wet Media):** Oil paint, acrylics, watercolour, gouache, encaustic (wax), and ink.
- **Printmaking:** Woodcut, linocut, etching, lithography, screen-printing (serigraphy), and monotyping.
- **Photography:** Analog film (35mm, large format) and digital photography.

3D & Spatial Media

- **Sculpture:** Carved stone (marble, granite), cast metal (bronze), modelled clay (terracotta), wood, glass, and wire.
- **Craft & Textiles:** Ceramics (stoneware, porcelain), fibre art (weaving, embroidery), jewellery (precious metals, gems), and woodworking.
- **Architecture:** Concrete, steel, glass, and sustainable timber.

Performing Arts Media

- **Human Expression:** The physical body (dance, mime), the human voice (opera, singing, theatre), and movement (physical theatre).
- **Sound:** Musical instruments (strings, woodwinds, percussion, brass).
- **Theatrical Props:** Masks, costume design, and set pieces.

Digital & Electronic Media

- **Static Digital:** Raster graphics, vector graphics (mathematical paths), pixel art, and game design.
- **Dynamic/Time-Based:** 2D/3D animation, CGI, motion graphics, and video art.
- **Interactive:** Virtual Reality (VR), Augmented Reality (AR), video games, and creative coding.
- **AI & Algorithmic:** Generative adversarial networks (GANs) and fractal art.
