



## **EMS PLACEMENT GUIDANCE**

## You will require:

- Your own vehicle as you will be required to meet vets on farm (Please note we cover 4 to 5 counties within the South East, and you may be required to drive long distances throughout your day)
- Clean wellies and waterproofs in a waterproof bag
- Enough to eat and drink for the whole day
- Please dress smartly, but comfortable and weather appropriate

Please touch base with the EMS coordinator via students@thelivestockclinic.co.uk the Thursday before you are due to start to enquire about start time and location for the following week.

While we do have an office base in wood street village it is not manned 24/7 and staff are primarily ambulatory and tend to drop in and out as necessary.

During quiet periods you are free to go home as long as you are close enough to get back to Guildford within about 15 minutes or meet the vet on farm for any urgent cases that come in.

While working hours are generally 9am - 5.30pm, the nature of farm work is unpredictable, with some quiet days and some very long days. You are welcome to attend weekend and night calls if you would like to but they are not mandatory

Please bring any paperwork with you ideally before but definitely on your last day otherwise you may experience delays in its return to you.
