Knowing how to safely foot trim small ruminants is essential as part of a farm foot care health plan.

While we don't advise routine foot trimming in sheep, some breeds do require more intervention than others.

Goats generally seem to require more routine trimming to keep their feet balanced and disease free.

Knowing how to perform a routine trim forms the basis of lameness identification and management
