



“Chimp’s Termite Mound”

Recipe to use with JANE GOODALL by Jo S. Kittinger

Chimpanzees are famous for using tools when getting food. Sometimes they use a rock to break open nuts. Other times they use a small stick or reed to fish termites out of a termite mound. You can pretend you are a chimp, with a termite mound, with this recipe. Use a toothpick as your tool to eat the white chocolate “termite” chips.

Ingredients:

1 banana
Smooth peanut butter
Miniature white chocolate chips
Toothpicks

Directions:

Peel banana and cut in half, so you have two “stumps” with flat ends on which to sit.

Smear peanut butter on each stump and roll in white chips.

Try to capture the white chocolate “termites” with a toothpick to eat, like chimps use a twig to get termites from a mound.
