

SDYJO Policy & Agreement

- 1) All students in SDYJO ensembles must remain in good standing in their school music programs concurrent to their participation in our ensembles. Being in good standing in their music programs means that they participate successfully in some aspect of their school program (provided there is a music program) while a student is in SDYJO.
- 2) All school performances take precedence over SDYJO ensembles. We will work around the student's school schedule and, when necessary, will rehearse and perform without members of our ensembles. One of the primary goals of SDYJO is to prepare students to achieve greater levels of musicianship. We expect that the skills and attitudes learned by SDYJO will be shared with the students' school music programs.
