2022 Russian River Valley Pinot Noir

Hill Family Vineyard

Sustainably farmed Hill Family Vineyard sits just south of the town of Healdsburg in the middle reach of the Russian River Valley. This area is the perfect place for growing Pinot Noir with the cool breezes and fog moving in every afternoon throughout the growing season.



2022 gave us a light crop of superb quality. This select block planted on low vigor rootstocks has a mixture of three clones: Pommard 4 with its strawberry and woody aromas, Dijon 115 that provides structure and cherry fruit and the Swan selection contributing spice and green floral notes and weight. The fruit was hand-harvested and de-stemmed for fermentation. The wine was then aged for 10 months in French Oak barrels, 10% new.

This Pinot Noir is bright red with aromas of cranberry red cherry fruit and cardamom spice. The taste is like wild plums and with a texture that is rich, soft and silky.

Appellation: Russian River Valley, Sonoma County

Variety: 100% Pinot Noir

Clonal composition: 72% Pommard 4 (clone 91), 21% Dijon 115 (clone 73) and 7% Swan (clone 97).

Alcohol: 14.1% *pH:* 3.68
