empowerment with us as we focus on all things pregnancy, baby, and parenting.

Our mission is to offer valuable information on maintaining a healthy pregnancy, raising a healthy child, and leading a healthy lifestyle. What is a community baby shower?

A community baby shower is just like a baby shower at your home but on a much larger scale. At Fresh Starts Community Baby Shower, we educate and have fun while doing it! With close to 500 in attendance, we play fun games, give away great prizes while educating and empowering the new and expecting mothers.





Why a Community Baby Shower?

Memphis has the highest infant mortality rate among the nation's 60 largest cities. Baby deaths in Memphis are double that of the average rate of the national. **An infant dies in Shelby County every 43 hours.**

In 2002, 202 babies did not see their first birthday. Think about that. That is enough babies to fill 10 kindergarten classrooms. Several Memphis ZIP codes have infant death rates higher than scores of Third World countries. North Memphis' 38108, which include the tattered communities of Douglass and Hollywood, are deadlier for babies than Vietnam, El Salvador, and Iran. Infant mortality is the barometer of a community's problems:

- poverty,
- pollution,

- crime,
- lack of education,
- access to health care and
- safe, affordable housing.

Although, Black mothers nationwide are more than twice as likely to lose a child before age 1 than other women, Fresh Starts Community Baby Shower targets all races and backgrounds in the City of Memphis that are at risk of losing children prematurely. Memphis' infant death rate is higher than New York City and Dallas combined.



Local political and community leaders, alongside organizations like Fresh Starts Community Baby Shower, have increasingly recognized the urgent crisis of infant mortality in Memphis. For example, in 2022, Memphis' high infant mortality underscored the compelling need for ongoing and coordinated action. Although efforts to address these challenges have grown, they remain fragmented, with many programs disappearing as funding fluctuated. Despite these obstacles, FSCBS has remained a consistent and steadfast advocate in the fight to lower infant mortality, providing vital support and resources for vulnerable families across the city.

More than 60 percent of city high school students report to be sexually active, and a third have had four or more partners. Shelby County's teen pregnancy has declined, but it remains among the nation's highest demonstrating that, even with progress, our community still faces significant challenges that require collective action. Prematurity stands as the leading cause of infant deaths in Memphis and across the United States, accounting for at least 60 percent of these losses. In about half of these cases, the exact reasons for premature birth remain unknown.

Mothers experiencing economic or social hardship often encounter increased risks—such as limited access to nutritious food, quality prenatal care, or stable housing—that can contribute to early births. Due to various social and economic pressures, some mothers may face increased risks such as substance use or exposure to abuse. Unplanned or closely spaced pregnancies and insufficient prenatal care are also more prevalent in these circumstances. Many young mothers, including teenagers and those who have left school early, may have difficulty accessing timely, comprehensive healthcare.

Shelby County's eleven public health clinics, located in neighborhoods with the greatest need, serve thousands of patients each year, including many teens and their families—seeking reproductive health and prenatal services. Thousands more rely on Medicaid and private providers. Yet, last year, 604 mothers received no prenatal care, and hundreds more had insufficient care. At least one-third of pregnant teens did not receive adequate support during pregnancy.

This landscape underscores the vital importance of events like the Community Baby Shower. By joining us, you can help support local families, learn about vital health resources, and make a difference in our community's future. We invite you to be part of a unique opportunity to raise awareness, empower expectant and new mothers, and celebrate the promise of healthy beginnings. Your involvement helps ensure every child and family has the chance to thrive
