Patients in Cumberland Country last week were told their life-saving **renal dialysis** treatment will no longer be available through Vitalité Health Network in New Brunswick. My office has made several phone calls and have not been able to obtain any proof of this stoppage in care. I am requesting your Departments of Health for Nova Scotia and New Brunswick to meet urgently to ensure our chronic renal failure patients are not left without access to lifesaving treatment.

Our provinces have shared clinical health services for decades. As per the Canada Health Act, our residents should be able to receive healthcare services in any province or territory in the Country.
