

# Marble Sizes

Marbles have been given names based on their sizes.

**Toe Breakers** are 2 inches in diameter or larger. They are sometimes used in bowling-type marble games.

**Boulders** are 1-inch in diameter or larger. We only use Boulders (sometimes called “Toe Breakers”) in games where you lag the marble underhanded (page 8).

**Shooters** are 1/2 to 3/4-inches in diameter. They are used to hit smaller marbles. At tournaments, a shooter can be glass or stone but not metal.

**Target Marbles** are often used in marble games. They range in size from 1/2 to 5/8-inches in diameter.

**Peeweess** are the little marbles. They include any marble under 1/2-inch in diameter.

Mega® Marbles (FS-USA) have been given names, including the marbles pictured here.
