There are cost with running our program which include but are not limited to: paying the educators, educational platforms, laptops, curriculum shipments, projects, educational excursions and Community Based Instruction. There is also the cost of uniforms that will be mandatory for all students (in-person and virtual). Not that financial status will keep a student from being admitted however, there is a 400.00-dollar tuition per

month per student with a 20% discount for the 2nd and a 10% discount for the 3rd of the same household.

School Uniforms

Uniforms will be as follows: young ladies wear royal purple tops and young men wear royal blue tops and all wear black, grey or khaki bottoms (young ladies preferred to wear knee length or longer skirts). Scholars foot attire must be closed toed and heel, except during events that may require dress apparel. Head wraps, turbans, beanies, kufis, kippoth, yamakote are strongly encouraged.

We will provide the shirts at a cost of \$20 each, it will come with the school emblem pressed on. An order form will also be sent to you.

At GHATK, we value honoring the Feast Days outlined in Leviticus 23, and we strive to create a school calendar that reflects the needs of our families. To help us plan well, we ask that parents share the Feast Days their family observes—specifically Passover (Pesach), the first and last days of Unleavened Bread (Chag HaMatzot), Feast of Weeks/Pentecost (Shabuot), Trumpets (Yom Teruah), Atonement (Yom Kippur), and the first day of Week of Booths/Tabernacles (Sukkot) and the eighth day (Shemini Atzeret). By knowing these dates, we can ensure our calendar is as inclusive as possible and that students are supported in keeping these holy days.
