

# WHJBSL District COVID-19 Safety Protocols

**SAFETY is the highest priority for the WHJBSL and its league members.**

Safety for EVERYONE -- our players, coaches, parents, families, umpires, support staff, and friends, too.

As the Coronavirus Pandemic continues to exist within our communities, safety protocols are still in place for outdoor youth sports activities. The Board of the WHJBSL encourages everyone to follow CDC recommendations by wearing masks when appropriate and to socially distance 6' from non-family members.

Please review the following list of safety protocols for each district in the WHJBSL before heading out to games. Not all districts have the same guidelines. We simply ask that everyone do their part to respect and follow the guidelines set forth in each district. Thank you.

## **ANDOVER**

- Social distancing and masks are recommended for all spectators, players, and coaches while watching games.
- Masks are REQUIRED when indoors.

## **BEL AIRE**

- Please wear a mask indoors and when unable to social distance at least 6' outdoors.
- This includes umpires, coaches, and players in the dugouts or when in discussions.
- Umpires, coaches, and players are EXEMPT from wearing masks when actively participating in games.
- Bleachers have been removed so spectators may bring their own chairs.

## **CIRCLE/BENTON/TOWANDA**

- Masks and social distancing recommended.

## **EL DORADO**

- Masks are recommended when unable to socially distance at least 6' from non-family members.
- This includes umpires, coaches, and players in the dugouts or when in discussions.
- When actively participating in games, umpires, coaches, and players may refrain from wearing masks.
- We encourage spectators to bring their own chair to allow for proper social distancing. Bleachers are available.

## **PARK CITY**

- Masks recommended when unable to socially distance 6' apart.

## **VALLEY CENTER**

- If you do not feel well, **DO NOT** attend practices or games.
- When at the complex, keep socially distanced from non-family members the recommended 6'.
- Dugouts will be extended 10' to allow for social distancing by players. Please ask parents to **NOT** put their chairs within those boundaries so players have plenty of room to socially distance.
- Pre-game Coaches/Umpires Meeting: Coaches and Umpires are asked to wear a mask OR stay 6' apart.
- Professional Cleaning Services provided by CINTAS 1x per week.

## **WHITEWATER**

- Social Distancing recommended for umpires, coaches, players and spectators from different family units.
- Masks can be worn on personal judgment or what is best for your family.
