HOW FITTING IT IS THAT THE 'WELCOME TO LEITH' MOVIE PREMIERES TODAY ON THE 70TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE LIBERATION OF THE NAZI CONCENTRATION CAMP OF AUSCHWITZ!

The premiere of the film 'Welcome To Leith' produced by the film's two New York filmmakers Michael Beach Nichols and Christopher K. Walker is somehow fitting that it has been selected to be shown at the Robert Redford Sundance Film Festival in Park City, Utah this week.

Seventy years ago today the Nazi concentration camp at Auschwitz was liberated by Soviet soldiers. Auschwitz was a network of concentration camps built and operated in occupied Poland by Nazi Germany during the Second World War. More than 1 million Jews were murdered at Auschwitz as a result of Adolph Hitler's objective to rid the world of the Jewish problem, as he called it.

Cobb and his 'roomie Nazi' Dutton were eventually arrested and charged with 7 counts of 'terrorizing' with guns.

Unfortunately the Grant County Assistant States Attorney Todd Schwarz could not see fit to take the two men to trial and in the end let them go free with time served and some probation. This infuriated Leith Mayor Ryan Schock, Leith City Councilman and crime victim Lee Cook and Leith Website Developer and Media Relations Representative Gregory Bruce of New Leipzig.

The 3 men then decided to take to task charging the Grant County Assistant States Attorney Todd Schwarz with conduct unbecoming of a court official and put it before the North Dakota Supreme Court's Disciplinary Counsel. After many months of media coverage and hearings the court decided that Schwarz could indeed use foul language when interviewing crime victims. The City of Leith may have lost that battle but they at least kept Schwarz from becoming a judge. Unfortunately he has now been appointed Grant County's States Attorney and will continue on as he has unless he is stopped.

This film will certainly become a ground-breaking icon for towns around the country to emulate what the citizens of Leith and Grant County have done to eradicate the filth and the evil of Craig Cobb and his Nazism/White Supremacy agenda.

Mark my words the idiot Nazis will come after us again and once again we will drive them out of North Dakota.


