



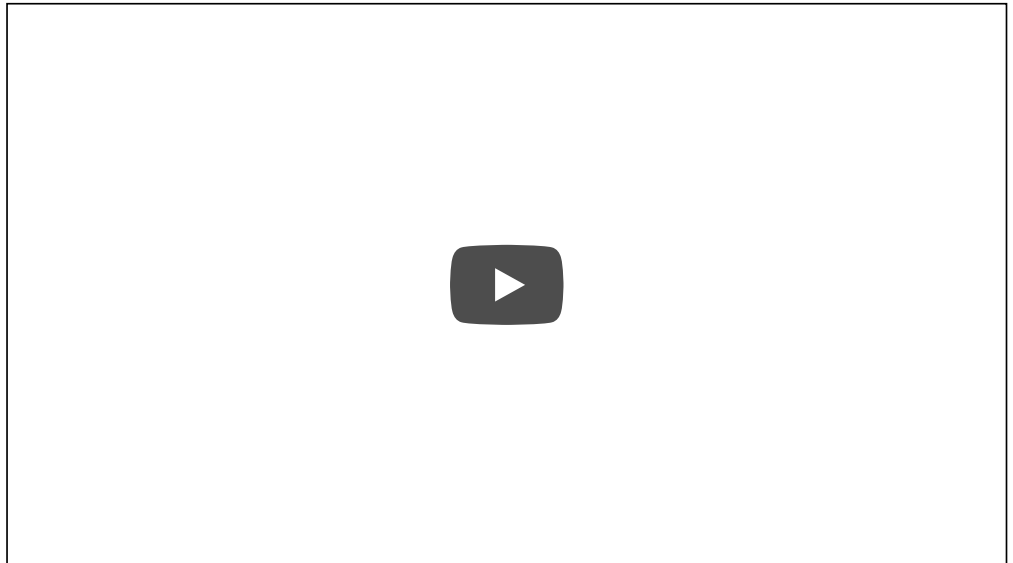

59:41 - States Attorney Elizabeth Ebert states "Corey's subdivision changes things." Commissioner Roth states "He (Corey) needs to build a private road for his people." States Attorney Ebert states "Does he (Corey) have a Home Owners Agreement?"

1:00:34 - Sheriff John Foss states "He (Corey) doesn't want him (the Sheriff) patrolling his property." States Attorney Ebert states "It (Corey's private gates) can be gated but NOT PADLOCKED!"

1:08:09 - Commissioner Roth states "Why didn't people go somewhere else and buy property instead of renting from him (Corey) and avoid the hassles since the entire area is congested?"

1:08:23 - Sheriff Foss states "It's not just trailers out there (Red Rock Resort) but people are building decks, patios and even garages."

1:08:32 - States Attorney Ebert states "My opinion is his (Corey) campers would need building permits for every additional structure." (Editor note: Upon checking with the Grant County Auditor Lynn Mutschelknaus building permits at a cost of \$15 are required even for farmers although some structures may be exempt from taxation)

1:09:08 - Commissioner Payne states "The commission gets very little information from him (Corey) regarding permits and is supposed to be doing way more than he's (Corey) doing..."it's like pulling 'hen's teeth' "... (referring to Corey).

1:09:50 - States Attorney Ebert states building without a permit is an "A" Misdemeanor."

Editor note: An "A" Misdemeanor as defined in the North Dakota Century Code is punishable by a \$3,000 fine and/or 1 year in jail.
