County Clerk

The County Clerk is responsible for maintaining public records, overseeing motor vehicle offices, and providing access to official documents.

Comptroller

The Comptroller serves as the county's chief financial officer, auditing operations and ensuring fiscal responsibility.

Family Court Judge

Family Court Judges preside over court cases related to family law, including child custody and support, domestic violence, and adoptions.

County Legislator

A County Legislator represents one of Ulster County's 23 districts, helping to establish local laws and policies while overseeing the county budget and delivery of government services.

Councilpersons

(Voting to fill **2 seats**)

A Councilperson serves on the governing body that creates or approves local laws and helps allocate the budget and personnel needed to run essential town services and community programs.

Supervisor

The Town Supervisor acts as the chief operating officer, managing municipal employees, overseeing daily operations and the town budget, and applying knowledge of local, county, and state laws to address key community issues.

Town Clerk

The Town Clerk posts official and legal notices, issues and archives vital records like birth, marriage, and death certificates, and may also serve as the Tax Collector in some municipalities.

Highway Superintendent

The Highway Superintendent oversees the maintenance of municipal (not county- or state-owned) roadways, supervises the highway workforce for road upkeep and snow removal, and manages the department's budget.

Town Justice

A Town Justice presides over the Town Court, handling criminal, traffic, and small civil cases, and has the authority to issue warrants, arraignments, and protective orders while applying local and state laws.
