Election Day November 4th 6am - 9pm

On Election Day Tuesday, November 4th vote at your polling site in your Election District. Hours are 6 am to 9 pm. Check your polling location *voterlookup.elections.ny.gov*

3 Vote by Absentee Ballot

Submit an early mail or absentee ballot request online at elections.ny.gov/request-ballot

- *** Once you submit a ballot request, you should vote using your mail ballot ***

 (if you request a ballot then show up at the polls, you'll have to vote by affidavit)
- October 25 Last day for board of elections to RECEIVE Absentee Ballot application by mail or online portal for general election ballot.
- November 3 Last day you may apply in person for an Absentee Ballot
- November 4 Last day to postmark your absentee ballot. Must be received by Nov 14th.
- November 4 Last day to drop off your absentee ballot in person at any county early voting location, election day polling location or the board of elections.
