
#### **Musical Add-Ons**

Scarborough Village Theatre is located inside the Scarborough Village Recreation Centre at 3600 Kingston Road. Free parking is available and the theatre is easily accessible by TTC via the 102 Markham, 86 Scarborough, or 905 Eglinton East Express buses.

As the theatre is in a City of Toronto facility, we support the city's environmental initiatives and will no longer sell water in single-use plastic bottles.

#### Theatre Scarborough Accessibility

The theatre is wheelchair accessible. If you require wheelchair or other special seating, please indicate this when ordering tickets. Whenever possible companion seating will be beside the wheelchair seating but we will always do our best to seat your entire party as close together as possible.

If you require seating that does not involve stairs, select seats in row E. If seats in row E are not available and you are able to climb some stairs, rows D and F are two steps below and above row E respectively.



Often called "a play for thinkers", Arcadia weaves a spectacular story that will not only touch the mind but also the heart.


