

P3: Micah L. McGuire, Age: 31, Birthday: November 23





Micah, 31, is from Chandler, Arizona. He is, a devout Christian, husband, and father. He is also, an Army vet, having served during Operation Iraqi Freedom.

During his time overseas, Micah and his unit participated in many missions across Northern Iraq. He helped defend the citizens of Iraq, during their first election, and participated in the training Iraqi soldiers and police. For his service, Micah received numerous awards and service ribbons.

When, Micah returned from his one year tour in the Middle East, he found himself a singe father of two young children. However, since the ending of his first marriage, he has since been reunited with his high school sweetheart, Alysia. They were married a few years ago, and have dedicated themselves, to raising their children, Malachi, Cassidy, and Melody, for the Lord. Micah's family, has been living with Alysia's parents for the past few months.

Micah, spent the following decade after his return, increasing his knowledge and skills by attending various institutes of higher learning. These included; the Art Institute of Seattle for

graphic design, the Art Institute of Phoenix, for video production, the Discovery Detective Academy, and the Motorcycle Mechanics Institute in Phoenix, where he became a certified Harley-Davidson motorcycle mechanic.

Through his volunteerism in the Arizona State Militia, Micah has also participated in training the citizens of Arizona, in things such as as First Aid, traffic control, and land navigation. Micah felt compelled, to answer the call to assist his state, after Legislation asking the civilians of Arizona to train to help in times of crisis, was signed into law, in 2010, by former Arizona Governor Jan Brewer. Through their training, these citizen volunteers, have helped with various events including Veteran events, parades, and more. They have also, volunteered their time with other organizations, such as Habitat for Humanity.

In the spring of 2014, Micah headed to Nevada with food, water, and medical supplies, after hearing unconfirmed rumors that citizens had been harmed during a protest at the Bundy Ranch. "He had no prior knowledge of any of the legal situations involved with the Bundy family in Bunkerville and merely went to observe the protest. Once at the protest site, Micah watched a crowd standing in a wash, under a bridge, as they stared down the barrels of some thirty-plus armed gunmen, who were working for the Bureau of land Management and were telling the crowd by way of a megaphone that they had orders from the BLM to kill them. As Micah watched from a hilltop in horror he thought the only way he could possibly help would be to use his own body as a shield for the women and children below if the bullets started flying. Thankfully the BLM agents stood down and no one was hurt. He went home and posted a picture to Facebook, stating that he was "proud" that no one was killed that day, but feared it may happen again."

After, his return from Nevada, Micah spent the next two years, volunteering as a street minister. Micah, "has dedicated his life to helping the unsaved understand the Gospel of Salvation, as well as helping those already saved in growing stronger in a deeper relationship to our Lord and Savior."

His time as a street minister, ended on March 3, 2016, when he was tackled and arrested by Federal Agents, on his way to work. He is now being held in the Nevada Southern Corrections Center, in Pahrump, or as Micah has put it, he was "*kidnapped*" and is now being "held as a political prisoner".

In an early letter sent to his father, Micah wrote, "It's hard to get over our shock of this whole situation. I'm trusting God and know He is my only chance..." In the same letter, Micah told his father, he had been spending a lot of time on his Bible studies, "I first read Luke thru John, then wrote every verse I liked out of the whole New Testament. About 20 pages worth or so then I re-read those pages every day. Now I'm doing my detailed study of Christ in Matthew. I'm diagramming and decoding His parables." This intense study, has allowed Micah the time to compose two Bible Study guides, Winning the War, and Stronger Christian Soldiers, which are available for purchase.
