

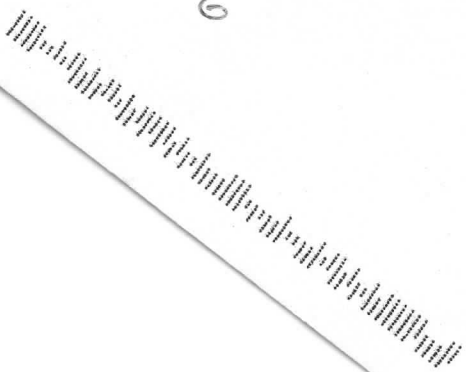

I get so excited about so many different verses and promises and prophecies.

Let us remember I am charged with "conspiracy", then let's find ourselves

in I Peter 3 starting in verse 8 but with particular attentions on 13 & 14. First

(NIV)

vs 13 "The Lord Almighty is the
one you are to regard as holy, he is
the one you are to fear, he is the one
you are to dread"
