Currently, the Chilcotin National Congress members are awaiting President Trump's approval of the Chilcotin ambassador to the USA and our Chilcotin embassy, as well as establishing foreign relations between our two countries.

Several countries around the world are ready to recognize the new country status of the Chilcotin, but have been threatened by Canada if they continue to support and work with our new country, which shows the level of corruption the Prime Minister and his government are willing to engage in.

Since 2015, Grand Chief Stanley Stump, Sr. has repeatedly attempted correspondence and negotiations with Canada and Prime Minister Trudeau to be only ignored and attacked without cause, doubling down of Canada's unprovoked hostile invasion and takeover of the first aboriginal Country of the Chilcotin. Prime Minister Trudeau continues to steal all the nation's revenue and resources, continued holding of approximately 300 Tsilhqot'in children hostage, bribing elected chiefs to pose as usurped authorities, as well as kidnapping and attempted murder of Chilcotin leaders such as myself. The violence of Prime Minister Trudeau and Canada demands justice, which the new Country of the Chilcotin and the Chilcotin National Congress will seek via war crimes indictments in the international courts.

The Chilcotin need not secede from Canada and BC, as technically "the Caribou Chilcotin area was never really part of BC or Canada" because the hereditary Tsilhqot'in people never sign a treaty with BC or Canada. Therefore, the Chilcotin need only assert its authority, which BC and Canada are obliged to respect and uphold. As you may recall, the Supreme Court of Canada acknowledged the Tsilhqot'in Nations' right to title, but what you may not know is that in 1995, the BC Supreme Court, in *Toosey Indian Band v. West Fraser Ltd.* acknowledged historical documents reaching back to the 1800's which outlines the borders of the Chilcotin and declares Chilcotin sovereignty and independence.

It is with shame and disgrace that Prime Minister Trudeau will be remembered in his treatment of aboriginal people if this Prime Minister does not immediately cease and desist his assault of our new Christian aboriginal Country of the Chilcotin. We trust that as an honourable member of parliament, you will be able to address this urgent matter before the Prime Minister starts murdering innocent people in the Chilcotin and lives will be lost needlessly by military and army tanks the Prime Minister sent to the Williams Lake area army base in violation of Universal Supreme Court orders for the RCMP, the BC judiciary and Crown counsel to vacate the territory.
