**Subject:** (U//LES) Possible sovereign/militia member presence at upcoming court hearings for detained sovereign citizen/militia members.

**Summary:** (U//LES) On 03/10/2011, the FBI and Alaska State Troopers, arrested Assembly Post (AP)/ Alaska Peacemakers Militia (APM) members August Francis 'Schaeffer' Cox, [redacted] and [redacted] Given Cox, [redacted] and [redacted] association with the sovereign citizen and militia groups, there could be a presence of fellow sovereign/militia members at their respective hearings.

**Details:** (U//LES) Schaeffer Cox, proclaimed leader of the Alaska Assembly Post (AP), Alaska Peacemakers Militia (APM), and his fellow members [redacted] and [redacted] were arrested by FBI agents and Alaska State law enforcement officers on 03/10/2011. The [redacted] and Cox were arrested regarding a conspiracy to murder an identified US federal judge, the judges family, and an employee of the Internal Revenue Service. [redacted] was arrested regarding federal weapon violation charges. [redacted] was arrested for obtaining a list of targets regarding Cox's murder plot.

(U//LES) Cox previously claimed to have a militia membership of 3500 persons within Alaska, however according to CHS reporting [redacted]

(U//LES) FBI Anchorage assess with medium confidence that remaining members of Cox's identified militia group could be present at the arrested members respective court hearings.

(U) [redacted] are set to appear before a federal judge on 05/16/2011. Cox and [redacted] are set to appear before a federal judge on 05/23/2011. [redacted] is set to appear before a state judge on 05/30/2011.

**Recommendations:**

(U//LES) Develop a CHS within the AP and APM community to collect intelligence on the operational plans of the remaining militia members.

(U//LES) Identify any militia members who could be capable to formulate a plan to attack identified Alaskan courthouses.

(U//FOUO) FBI Anchorage should provide outreach to United States Marshalls Service regarding possible militia activity near the Federal Courthouse in Fairbanks, AK.

(U//FOUO) FBI Anchorage should provide outreach regarding possible militia activity to security members responsible for guarding the Alaska state courthouse in Fairbanks, AK.

(U//FOUO) Increase security within the Fairbanks State/Federal courthouses.

(U//FOUO) Increase security for the transporation of captured members.
