I know PF very well, better than most of his friends and some of his family, not as a girlfriend, as a caring friend that will always love and respect him. He is not anything like the profile that prison records indicate and I can not imagine how he is able to deal with prison life with his good natured, free spirit, and love of life being constantly stifled.
