
my dear friend & brother Will,

By 12 I was loading them. Cowboys start early. We even baled soybean straw in the fall. Our old 45 International bale kept going and going. It rests in the pine grove where my grandfather lived, last I knew. It rests and rusts. Memories it's still bright red, in the dust and smell of hay all around it.

One year, 16, I caught a scrabble calf on a very muggy night at the Butler County Fair — raised her and waited to sell her a year later. I do know how it is to grow close to our livestock. We had 100's of cattle but she was special. I felt like I betrayed her. Some of those feelings linger like my ancestors all the way back to Abraham, our cattle were an important part of our lives. I've seen in your letters and photos, well, you can relate. God bless you. Our heart in it is proof of that. I love it!

The song is wrong. I did not "leave my heart in San Francisco". It's much simpler than that. Our memories ^{is} a gift from The Lord, our Creator. (Proverbs 3:5, 6).

Longest day of 2018, now past. A few minutes of daylight less each day until last week of December. Meantime crops grow toward maturity. The Lord's purpose one day at a time. Let us enjoy His presence ours always, thanks to the victory He alone has secured.


A fellow traveler has loaned me a book, "Fighting In Hell" a documentary based on interviews with 4 ranking German officers about fighting the Russians in WW II.




Surely you and yours are in Jesus provision and all is working for the good of those who love God - Amen (Romans 8:28).
