Canada threatens the newly recognized sovereign and independent country of the Chilcotin with full scale, all out war! Continued unprovoked, hostile aggression and attacks by Canada against the new peaceful, lawabiding aboriginal Christian country of the Chilcotin reaches new heights, with Canada citing "no one will hold Canada accountable" and "who can hold Canada accountable?" as well as "Canada can attack whoever it pleases and get away with it."

Head of State Hereditary Grand Chief Stanley Stump Sr., of the Chilcotin filed an Application with the International Court of Justice in order to stop Canada from illegally occupying and invading the Chilcotin for 150 years, to stop Canada from kidnapping and jailing Chilcotin leaders, to stop Canada from kidnapping and trafficking Chilcotin youth and children, and to stop Canada from stealing the Chilcotin's national revenue, etc.

Since 1763 Canada owes the Chilcotin National Congress 25 cents for every dollar spent across Canada but Canada has not paid to date. Also, Prime Minister Justin Trudeau recently exonerated Chilcotin leaders and families thereby owing the Chilcotin National Congress members reparation costs for murdering past ancestors but Canada to date has refused to compensate the Chilcotin National Congress members after 150 years.

Canada's response to the Chilcotin's ICJ Application was that Canada does not accept the jurisdiction of the International Court of Justice, hoping to evade liability.

Chilcotin Minister of Justice says, "Canada will not be allowed to avoid the rule of law by making claims it does not recognize the International Court of Justice's jurisdiction. Canada's crimes can and will be stopped. Canada can and will be held accountable for all the years Canada engaged in war crimes against the people of the Chilcotin."
