POMafia #13; CONTINUED RETALIATION FOR MEDICAL LAWSUIT:

Gary M. Northington 193035

Dear Brother Rudy and Sister Erin,

This continues a saga of retaliation since JUNE 2016 with PREDATORY abuses by PUBLIC SERPENTS of SE MI, involving MELODY A. PAULEY WALLACE (of Perry and WILLIAMSTON, MI, (517) 655-4498) and her subordinate RICHARD D. RUSSELL (Lansing, MI, (517) 373-3366). In JANUARY 1992, WALLACE lamented that I "did not have enough property" to take to harass, intimidate and "punish me for filing a lawsuit".

The present series of events began in 2016 when I filed a Federal lawsuit on DR. BADAWI KHADER (new middle name) ABDELLATIF for GENOCIDE by the Privatized Medical NAZIS of CORIZON HEALTH INC. (105 Westpark, Suite 200, Brentwood, TN 37027, MI ph # (517) 853-2555). POMafia #11 and #12 are of this 2017 to 2019 series of events ORDERED by WALLACE upon request of Assistant Attorney General PETER YUANG HO (Lansing, (517) 373-6434) after he filed 2 Motions to Dismiss in the lawsuit. Asst. AG KRISTEN D. SIMMONS replaced HO when he lost the Motions in DECEMBER 2017. This lists the events occurring after POMafia #12.

On 26 JULY 2018, I learned Asst. AG James E. Long (Lansing, (517) 373-6434), who represents MDOC in my 2nd lawsuit on my guitar and music property, had told JCF STAFF of POMafia #12 to NOT transfer my property with me to LCF, in violation of MDOC Policy. Grievance #283 herein is the LCF equivalent of #282 filed on this at JCF (POMafia #12).

JANE ROHRIG returned #283 to me unfiled with a note (p. 1). It was resent to her on 01 AUGUST (p. 3). When asked about refiled #283, ROHRIG said, "Will be processed within the week, if received (she had it, p. 2). On 06 AUGUST, I filed #285 on refusal to file #283 (p. 2). #285 was shredded by LCF Inspectors T. Chrisman and W. Matthews without response.

On 13 AUGUST 2018: ROHRIG and DW BRYAN MORRISON (Coldwater, (517) 278-6202) falsely rejected #283 as holding "extraneous information" (p. 4). At JCF, CHRISTINE HEMRY had falsely rejected #282 as "grieving policy". At LCF, JANE ROHRIG falsely rejected #283 as "extraneous information which is conclusory rejection. Their own words prove them false since #282 and #283 are the same. STEP 2 and 3 Appeals (p. 5) are self-explanatory. RICHARD D. RUSSELL always gives abusive meaningless canned responses (p. 6).
