

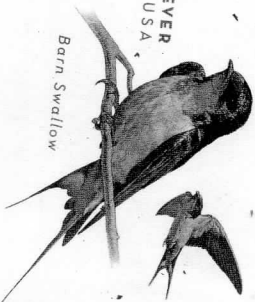

OCTOBER 2025, I discovered after Hearing Investigator — AUSTIN picked up my request for documents and witness statements, required by MDOC Misconduct Policy, late in the afternoon of 06 OCTOBER 2025, that AUSTIN did not get the documents or witness statements for which C/O THELEN had handed AUSTIN the requesting documents — I had written. Sgt. Brooks filled out the Misconduct Report saying that documents were requested; I read that. I had sent AUSTIN a kite requesting her to pick up my documents and witness statement requests. I was hospitalized, after asking AUSTIN to pick up my requests, until 06 OCTOBER 2025. AUSTIN denied me Due Process and Equal Protection by refusing, contrary to Misconduct Policy, to fulfill said requests in Retaliation for my

First Amendment exercise about JCF STAFF corruption.

Dear Rudy and Erin, MDOC's latest series of attacks began with coercion, attempts at intimidation, harassment, and threats of physical harm as I prepared to file my Application for Leave to Appeal in the Michigan Supreme Court about the false 1st Degree Murder Conviction that MDOC Records Administrator Christina Cakender put on my MDOC Record, S. Ct. No. 168417. This series of events, still ongoing, is orchestrated

by Assistant Attorney General H. Steven Langschwager (517) 335-3055 and Joseph Yung-Kuang Ho through JCF Litigation Coordinator Kimberly Napier (517) 780-5121 (Yep! She's got 2 jobs; maybe 2 pay-checks). (Is Joseph Ho related to Chief CCP Spy Peter Yuang Ho?)

I sent you a copy of my 29 OCTOBER 2024 Medical Record from Henry Ford Hospital (HFAH) where I went into syncope, became cyanotic and diaphoretic minutes after Warden Brian Morrison's hit man sprayed me in the face with a Fentanyl loaded perfume atomizer as I was leaving JCF for HFAH (Hopefully ^{my letter &} you got it). Blood flow to my brain was lost for 2 minutes, and I've ^{since} had problems writing without missing words in sentences, missing alphabetical characters in words and not knowing the meaning of words I have known for most of my life (I went through this in 2016 after Open Heart Surgery where syncope occurred for 5-10 minutes). This was the beginning of Warden Brian Morrison's attempts to obstruct my court access.

Hearing Investigator Austin here is refusing to give ~~give~~ ^{alleged} me the documents needed to void this false misconduct for "Threatening Behavior," which is controlled by orders from aforesaid Assistant Attorney Generals through Admin. Asst./ Litigation Coordinator Kim Napier.

In my next letter, I'll tell you about attempts to murder me by certain staff here. I have the proofs.

On 12 NOVEMBER 2025, via communications, I became aware that you, the aforementioned, formed a RICO agreement to deprive me of a CSJ-418 Appeal form and a copy of the Hearing Report which, according to RICO (18 USC, Secs. 1961 et seq.) includes therein depriving me of: (1) a college education and funding thereof (Goss v Lopez, 419 US 565, 573-574 (—)); (2) Goldberg v Kelly, 397 US 254, — (1970); Logan v Zimmerman, 455 US 422, 432 (1982)); (2) State/MDOC employment and funds derived thereof (Connell v Higginbotham, 403 US 207, — (1971); James v Strange, 507 US 128, 140-141 (1995) (wages and intimate personality)); (3) disability benefits and rights required to be provided (42 USC, Secs. 12101 et seq.; Hemi Group v NYC, 559 US 1, 16-18 (2010) (causal connection and fraud); Logan, 455 US at 430, fn. 4 (1982) (State tort claim); Mathews v Eldridge, 424 US 319, — (1976) (disability benefits/rights); and (4) other forms of property and property rights thereof (Chattanooga Foundry v Atlanta, 203 US 390, 396 (1960) (extra expenses and hardship)). Further included under RICO is Obstruction of Justice encompassing all aforesaid elements caused by your refusal to provide me the CSJ-418 form and a copy of the Hearing Report, needed to file State Administrative Appeal under Policy PD 03.03.105, Section WWW. Forthwith cease and desist from your RICO Obstruction; provide me with the CSJ-418 form and 07 OCTOBER 2025 Hearing Report.

STEP II — Reason for Appeal STEP I Response denied as ~~MDOC~~ a false document requiring discharge of CRR Troy Cobb. The Grievance was dropped into the mailbox of RUM RIKAR in I-Unit on 09 OCTOBER 2025. Rikar was on vacation for 7 to 10 days, so JCF apparently not having a replacement for Rikar is delay culpable to MDOC, NOT CULPABLE TO NORTHINGTON. STEP I Response shows a 7-day delay from 20 OCTOBER 2025 signing of Response by Troy Cobb to 27 OCTOBER 2025 mailing of Response to Northington. Calculating a 7-day delay from Cobb's 20 OCTOBER 2025 ^{mailing to me} ~~extending to me~~ Response of Grievance, ~~MDOC~~ means GC Cobb actually received the Grievance on 13 OCTOBER 2025 which is a RECEIPT of GRIEVANCE 2 BUSINESS DAY AFTER MAILED. HI AUSTIN failed to do her MINISTERIAL JOB. PD 03.03.105, Sec. V. Do your jobs.

STEP III — Reason for Appeal CRR Troy COBB has difficulty ~~pro~~ timely processing Grievances because COBB HAS "WET BRAIN FROM DRINKING TOO MUCH ALCOHOL AT THE BAR HE RUNS. In Grievance JCF-25-10-2203-22G, which was time stamped as received on 20 OCTOBER 2025, just like this grievance, despite being mailed 3 days earlier. The delay here was either JCF RUM Rikar or GC Cobb, not Northington. Grievance Policy states: "Within five business after attempting to resolve a grievable issue with staff," a prisoner must mail a grievance. PD 03.02.130. It, 2207, was not "untimely." It was mailed in 2 days. Answer merits.
