

MOTION TO SHOW FOURTH DISTRICT COURT OF APPEALS AND STATE ATTORNEY'S OFFICE VIOLATED APPELLATE RULES AND PETITIONER'S CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS

Petitioner Private Attorney General Anthony Williams, a servant of the Most High Yahweh Elohim Yahshua, submits this Motion To Show Fourth District Court of Appeals and State Attorney's Office violated Appellate Rules and Petitioner's Constitutional Rights. In support of this motion Petitioner states the following facts

I. INITIAL BRIEF TIMELY FILED AND SERVED ON STATE ATTORNEY'S OFFICE

Petitioner's Original Initial Brief was sent to the 4th D.C.A. and the State Attorney's office on August 29, 2017 and placed in the hands of Officer N. Segui as reflected by the Certificate of Service Filed with the brief.

However, the clerk didn't file stamp the brief until December 4, 2017 which is 3 months after the brief was mailed to them and the State Attorney's office. There is no precedence for an appeals court to hold a pro se Appeal brief 3 months before filing it. Nevertheless, the State was served and had at least 4 months from it's filing to file a response to Petitioner's pro se Appeal Brief. The State failed to answer the brief and according to the appellate rules the 4th D.C.A. was mandated to grant Petitioner's appeal and overturn the conviction.

II. INTENTIONAL CONCEALMENT FROM INITIAL BRIEF BEING DOCKETED ON THE CASE SUMMARY FOR CASE NO. 17-000074-CF10A

On the 12th day of February 2025, Petition sent a Motion For Copy of Docket to the Broward County clerk of circuit and county court that would show

all of the documents that were filed in Petitioner's case. Petitioner received a copy of the docket on March 3, 2025 and scrutinized the docket to see if his appeal brief was acknowledged.

On June 6, 2017 Petitioner filed a Writ of Prohibition and was acknowledged by the Fourth D.C.A. and given the case number 4D17-1674. On June 23, 2017 Petitioner filed his Notice of Appeal which was also acknowledged and docketed on the case. On June 27, 2017 the 4th D.C.A. issued a Certificate of Indigency declaring Petitioner indigent to be relieved of costs.

On July 13, 2017 the 4th D.C.A. issued an order redesignating Petitioner's Certificate of Immediate Review to be a Petition for Writ of Prohibition. After almost a year after filing the Initial Brief, Petitioner sent a letter to the 4th D.C.A. regarding the status of his appeal on May 22, 2018 and was notified that his appeal brief was filed incorrectly as a regular document by the clerk and not as an ~~initial~~ initial brief. The court then assigned a public defender (PD) to refile Petitioner's brief. Petitioner notified the PD that he already had his appeal filed in Case # 4D17-1674 and that all he wanted the PD to do is just refile what Petitioner already filed. Instead the PD drafted his own appeal and left out many of the grounds and all the exhibits that Petitioner had in his original appeal brief. The appeal was given case number 4D18-2359 and was completed

on April 22, 2019 and percuram affirmed by the 4th D.C.A. on December 27, 2019 without issuing an opinion. Nowhere on the docket does it list or even mention that Petitioner Filed his Initial Brief that was Filed stamped on December 4, 2019. Petitioner's original appeal brief contained Exhibits that proved Petitioner's innocence and that all the documents Filed were pre-approved by the appropriate governmental agencies. These exhibits were denied being presented at trial as evidence because the State Filed a Motion In Limine that was granted by the judge so that Petitioner could not present or even mention these facts to the Jury. The order from the Judge stated that Petitioner could not make a reference to the Jury ~~that the State~~^{to} the

FACT that: 1) Other states chose not to prosecute defendant for Grand Theft or unlawful filing of documents or records against real property; 2) the FACT that other defendants filing of similar documents in other states has in any way been sanctioned or approved by those states or governmental agencies; 3) these charges of grand theft and unlawful filing of documents against real estate violate double jeopardy principles; 4) that any similar mortgage note and/or UCC lien was scrutinized by any Anti-Predatory Lending Database in Illinois or that any jurisdiction in the United States of America authorized or sanctioned filings of the same, or that this is prima facie evidence that these documents are not fraudulent; 5) that there are pending or civil lawsuits here or elsewhere wherein Anthony Williams or Mortgage Enterprise Investments is a party. This Motion In Limine was

Exhibit 17 in Petitioner's Initial Brief to show that Petitioner was prevented from presenting exculpatory evidence from governmental agencies approving the very documents the State was claiming were fraudulent.

It is quite evident why the State didn't want Petitioner's Initial Brief acknowledged and ruled on because it would have mandated a reversal of Petitioner's conviction when the governmental documents approving Petitioner's documents and company (and that none of it was fraudulent) were denied presentation to the jury.

III. FUNDAMENTAL MISCARriage OF JUSTICE AND ACTUAL INNOCENCE

"To establish actual Innocence a movant must demonstrate in light of all the evidence it is more likely than not that no reasonable juror would have convicted him." Muth v. Fongren, 676 F.3d 815, 819 (9th Cir. 2012). (See Exhibit 2, Declaration of William Wagoner)

Petitioner has proven and demonstrated factual innocence from trustworthy eyewitnesses (e.g. Affidavit from Co-defendant) and a plethora of evidence that was denied being presented at trial which Petitioner outlined in detail in his initial brief. "To demonstrate Factual innocence, a movant must produce new reliable evidence - whether it be exculpatory scientific evidence, trustworthy eyewitness accounts or critical physical evidence - that was not presented at trial." Schulz v. Delo, 513 US 298, 324 (1995).

There is no precedence in the history of American jurisprudence where a person assisting a homeowner fight their foreclosure be charged with grand theft of the house that the client has been living in for 8 years. Even squatters who just take over a house can't

be charged with grand theft because of adverse possession laws in the State of Florida and all other states.

It is not feasible that the court can view this evidence along with Petitioner's original brief and it not undermine the court's confidence in the outcome of Petitioner's criminal proceedings. Milton v. Secy Dept. of Corr., 342 F. App'x 528, 531-32 (11th Cir. 2009).

Therefore, a fundamental miscarriage of justice has occurred and Petitioner has demonstrated that he is actually innocent of the state offense because no house at no time was grand thefted. Bousky v. United States, 523 US 614, 623 (1998) (actual innocence means factual innocence, not mere legal insufficiency).

Petitioner is actually innocent and a fundamental miscarriage of justice would result if the Petitioner's conviction is not overturned.

CONCLUSION

Based upon the foregoing stated facts and reasons, Petitioner appeals to this higher court to undo the injustice done to Petitioner and Petitioner's family, and overturn his conviction.

DECLARATION OF WILLIAM WAGENER


I, William Wagener, do declare, depose and state under penalty of perjury that the following are true, correct and complete to the best of my knowledge, information and beliefs:

1. I am over the age of 18 and competent to state the facts herein.
2. I have known Anthony Williams (hereinafter "Anthony"), since 2015, Ten (10) years to date. Anthony was and is not a violent criminal.
3. I am a TV producer for over 25 years, to present. I have a TV show called: "On Second Thought." I invited Anthony to appear on my show several times to discuss his activism against unlawful foreclosures, the Judicial system's corruptions, and the Law Enforcement corruptions.
4. I can attest that everything Anthony was doing before his unlawful incarceration, were lawful and legally in compliance according to the law.
5. When Anthony was incarcerated in Florida, I flew to Florida to visit and to interview him, being that I am a professional member of the media.
6. I was denied visitation with Anthony in Florida, during visitation hours which I was not given any justifiable reason(s), as to why Anthony's access to the media was denied, other than I was told that I needed the prosecutor to approve it.
7. Anthony was then transferred to Hawaii. Again, I flew my camera man, Stephen P. to Hawaii to interview him. Similarly, Stephen P. was denied by the FDC-Honolulu, and they did not give me any justifiable reason(s) why Anthony's access to the media was denied.
8. I am a journalist for over 25 years. In all those years of my Professional Media career, I have never been denied visitation by the court system nor the prison system, anywhere in the United States, to interview any inmate.
9. I wrote to Judge Leslie Kobayashi to request for a video coverage of Anthony's Honolulu trial on January-February 2020, so people from the mainland, especially his families who could not fly to Honolulu to attend the trial, could also watch the trial.
10. I explained to judge Kobayashi that I have numerous video recorded other trials in the Ninth Circuit court. Anthony's trial was not a "high profile" case, that the media presence would not cause any disruption nor disturbance.
11. I received a subpoena (at 6 AM), to testify from the U.S. District Court in Hawaii for Anthony's trial in Jan-Feb. 2020, Case No. CR 17-00101-LEK. I was one of the numerous key witnesses for Anthony's trial from the mainland, which I was already confirmed to testify for Anthony. However, at the very last minute, a few days before the trial began, I was struck by Judge Leslie Kobayashi from testifying, and I was not given any justifiable reasons why she denied my rights to testify.

12. Had I been allowed to testify for Anthony, I would have been able to verify at his trial that everything Anthony was doing were lawful. Anthony was targeted because he exposed the corruptions in the judicial and law enforcement systems, especially, in regards to the illegal foreclosures, based on fake security loan instruments.
13. I have written letters to President Trump and President Biden, asking them to free this innocent man, however, they never responded to my plea.
14. Anthony's conviction was a gross and egregious miscarriage of justice to incarcerate and convicted a man for helping lay people, who had been taken advantage of, and violated their rights by an unjust system.
15. Anthony uploaded many videos on YouTube about his activism, which displayed his genuine intent of educating the public, displayed his character and his disposition to help innocent, lay people, even to his own detriment.
16. ~~There is NO JUSTICE, when an INNOCENT man sits in prison for 8 years to date, for a crime he did NOT commit.~~
