This collection, **Lattice Wear 2026**, is designed based on current peer-reviewed research into color perception and sensory processing.

Part 1: The Color Science (Peer-Reviewed)

According to research from **Wang and Sun (BMC Psychology, Dec 2025/2026)** and **Denton Office Design (2025)**, neurodivergent color preferences are highly specific:
