WHAT TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GO!!

- Tickets for parents and guests will be available for purchase at the Laycock St Theatre Box Office. They will be available for purchase from 21 May.
- Venue address is 5 Laycock St, Wyoming NSW 2250. Students need to enter via the rear stage door.
- Venue opens 8:00am. There will be NO access to tickets or dressing rooms before this time.
- All competitors and audience members must wear a wristband to enter the auditorium. Student wristbands are in the teacher registration bag and must be distributed by the teacher. Audience wristbands can be collected (prepurchased online) or purchased in-person from the box office.
- Each section will be awarded from 1st-5th. Awards will occur at the end of the morning and afternoon sessions.
- Audition entrants must meet the choreographer at the location outlined in the program 40 mins before their stage time. See meeting time and place in green on program.
- Music Uploads will open on Monday 19 June Schools and soloists (if applicable) must create a Music uploads account. All music must be submitted by Friday 20 June at the absolute latest. Any items without music by this date will be withdrawn.
- Your voice critiques will be sent to your music Uploads account after the afternoon session is awarded. You can click on 'Voice Critiques' in your music uploads account to access.
- Teachers must check-in at the registration desk in the foyer upon entry. Here, you will receive your competitor passes, dressing room locations and printed program if purchased.
- Students must remain silent in your marshalling area. A Marshall will come and get you to come to the marshalling area.
- Some dressing rooms are up a set of stairs, please ensure all items that you bring can be transported upstairs.
- Entrance is stage left and exit is stage right for your planning. There is room to 'run around'.

ADJUDICATOR Jegan Jeffrey-Rushton

Tegan Jeffrey-Rushton is a dance artist, choreographer and dance teacher based in Sydney, Australia. Tegan's movement language is a melting-pot of her diverse dance background - with a strong focus on storytelling, performance play and athleticism. After moving from Queensland to Sydney at sixteen, Tegan's training has been extensive, including: two years of full- time dance training at Brent street and Ettingshausens Pro - gaining her certificates IV and Diploma in Dance. She has also invested in extensive training internationally including a 3 month training trip to Los Angeles and multiple trips to Singapore, NZ, Japan to further her craft. Tegan's performance credits include productions such as "Carmen" by Opera Australia, "Colossus" by Stephanie Lake Company at Sydney Festival and assistant/ dancer for Los Angeles based choreographer - Jillian Meyers "Q&A" in Tokyo. Some other credits include artists and brands such as: Guy Sebastian, The Veronicas, Red Foo, Pepsi, Drew Barrymore x Wanderlust, KLP, Reebok, Mazda, Toyota, Avon Australia, Dr Lewinn, Zorali.

As a creative, Tegan recently directed and choreographed a sold-out season of her first site-specific show titled "Overture" which took out the overall 'Best Dance' award for the 2025 Adelaide Fringe Festival. Tegan hascontributed her creative vision to music videos such as Zela Margossian Quintet's "The Road" (featured on Nowness'), "Poison Ivy" by L-flora, "Breathe" by Nick Broadhurst. Driven by a strong work ethic and versatility, Tegan has had the opportunity to assist esteemed choreographers both in Australia and

internationally. Notable among these experiences are with Jillian Meyers in Los Angeles and Tokyo, as well as her contributions to projects led by Sarah Boulter, including

involvement in "Dancing With The Stars" in Australia.

Tegan's passion for teaching and educating has her a part of regular teaching faculty at full-time institutions such as Brent Street, Ev and Bow and Ettingshausens where she values nurturing foundational techniques, artistry and individual expression in her classes. Tegan's commitment to her craft extends beyond performance and choreography; she is deeply invested in continuous growth and development. Tegan remains dedicated to expanding her artistic horizons, enriching her movement vocabulary, and deepening her knowledge of the diverse facets of her craft.
