WHAT TO KNOW

Before you go..

- This program is now in FINAL mode. No further changes will be made.
- Music is to be uploaded to your Comp Admin Pro account by Friday 4 September at the latest.
- Your voice critiques will be sent to your Comp Admin Pro account at the end of the event day.

- Venue address is The Art House 19/21 Margaret St, Wyong NSW 2259
- Venue opens at 8:30am. There will be NO access to tickets or dressing rooms before this time.
- All competitors and audience members must wear a wristband to enter the auditorium. Student wristbands are in the teacher registration bag and must be distributed by the teacher. Students will only be permitted to watch from the auditorium if there is availability in the audience. Otherwise, they can cheer their teams from the side stage.
- Audience wristbands can be collected (pre-purchased online) or purchased in-person from the ticket desk if there is availability. We strongly recommend that you pre-purchase online with plenty of time to spare; events often sell out in advance. Once sold out, there will be no more tickets released.
- Each section will be awarded from 1st-5th. Awards will occur at the end of each session.
- Audition entrants must meet the choreographer at the location outlined in the program 45 mins before their stage time. See meeting time and place in green on program.
- Teachers must check-in at the registration desk upon entry. Here, you will receive your competitor passes, dressing room locations and printed program if purchased.
- A Marshall will come and get you to come to the marshalling area.
- Some dressing rooms are up a set of stairs, please ensure all items that you bring can be transported upstairs.
- Please ensure that all routines comply with the maximum of 40 dancers as stipulated in our rules. Any routine that exceeds this will receive a penalty. This rule is to ensure dancer safety and equity.
- Dance X is an opportunity for students to perform in a safe and encouraging environment. Please note that poor sportsmanship from students, staff or parents will not be tolerated. Please speak kindly to our staff; we are there to assist you!

Felicity King

Felicity King is a passionate dance educator, choreographer and Principal of The Dance Factory Performing Arts Centre (TDF) in Bathurst, which she has proudly owned for the past six years. With over 25 years of experience in dance, Felicity has trained and worked across a wide range of styles including Jazz, Tap (Glenn Wood & Tapatak Oz), Ballet (RAD), Contemporary, Lyrical, Hip Hop, Musical Theatre, Acrobatics and Dance Cirque. Felicity has over 10 years' experience teaching dance in NSW Primary Schools, working with students from kindergarten through to Year 6. She has been involved with the NSW Schools Spectacular, Western Region Dance Festival and State Dance Festival, providing students with valuable opportunities to perform and develop their skills. Felicity also created and produced her own school dance program, Schools on the Move, bringing quality dance education and performance opportunities directly into Western NSW schools. As a choreographer, Felicity has created numerous solo, group and production routines, with a strong focus on musicality, storytelling, technique and performance quality. Her students have achieved significant success across Western NSW eisteddfods, as well as at Showcase Nationals on the Gold Coast. In 2026, two of Felicity's students were selected to represent Team Australia at the International Dance Organisation (IDO) Tap World Championships in Prague. Felicity has been honoured to choreograph their routines for the international stage, preparing them to represent Australia at a world-class level. As an adjudicator, Felicity is passionate about providing dancers with positive, constructive and meaningful feedback. She believes in celebrating each dancer's individuality while encouraging them to continue developing their technique, artistry, musicality, confidence and love of dance.
