I. Student Criteria

All applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered:

The eligible high schools currently on this list are high schools whose students have heard Keri Anne's mission during a Foundation presentation

- A current student athlete (any sport)
- Must be accepted or enrolling at a college/university
- A 3.0 GPA**

While a 3.0 GPA is preferred, it is not required. Any student that still meets the other above requirements may still be considered regardless of GPA
