I. Student Criteria

All applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered:

- A current high school senior
- Must be accepted or enrolling at any college/university
- A minimum 3.0 GPA

III. Essay

Please include a single spaced essay (500 word minimum) with your application addressing one or more of the prompts below. Times New Roman or Arial 12 pt. font is preferred.

Please include your name and high school at the top of the page.

Essay Prompts:

- (1) Keri Anne's mission in life was to change the world through helping others. What are your current and future goals, and how do you plan to apply those goals to make a positive impact in your community?

OR

- (2) If you have had the opportunity to see our No More Empty Seats presentation at your school, please describe how our overall message made you feel. Did our message and Keri's story make a lasting impact? How do you think it will affect you either now or in the future?

OR

- (3) Describe the positive and negative impact you think that social media has on you and the people around you. Do you think that what you post on social media can affect your future in regards to your career, personal life, etc.? Explain how.

IV. Additional Materials (Required unless otherwise indicated)

- Copy of a college acceptance letter or other proof of enrollment
- One letter of recommendation from a coach, teacher, pastor, or other community leader
- **OPTIONAL:** copy of most recent progress report
