On December 6, 2022, Forensic Scientist (FS) Logan Mason and I responded to a request to take friction ridge exemplars from one subject at Idaho State Police, District 3, Investigations, located at 700 S. Stratford Dr., Meridian, Idaho, 83642. We arrived at approximately 1213 MST. We were met by Lt. Jack Catlin.

FS Mason and I recorded finger and palm exemplars from JOHN ROGERS SHOWALTER. We collected 3 inked fingerprint cards, 2 partial inked fingerprint cards, 4 adhesive lifts of full fingers and tips, 4 adhesive lifts of the right palm, and 5 adhesive lifts of the left palm.

All exemplars were turned over to Jack Catlin on December 6, 2022, at approximately 1332 MST.


We cleared the scene at approximately 1335 MST.

On 11/16/22 at approximately 1912 PST, Forensic Scientists (FS) Kerry Hogan, Hailey Youngling, Jennie Ayers, Wyatt Barie and I arrived at the Idaho State Police District 2 (ISP D2) office located at 2700 Old N S Hwy, Lewiston, Idaho 83501, to assist with a homicide investigation. Detective Talbott (ISP D2) was present upon our arrival. Detective Talbott briefed us on the scene information.

1122 King Rd.

On 11/17/22 at approximately 0854 PST, FS Hogan, Youngling, Ayers, Barie and I arrived at 1122 King Rd, Moscow, Idaho 83843. Detective Talbott was present upon our arrival. 1122 King Rd is a white colored three story home that faces north in a residential neighborhood. The house consists of 6 bedrooms and 3 bathrooms. The first floor consists of a west bedroom, a bathroom, a furnace room, an east bedroom and a stairway to the second floor. The second floor consists of a living room, a bathroom, a west bedroom, an east bedroom, a kitchen, a storage room under the stairs and a switchback staircase to the third floor. The third floor consists of a west bedroom, a landing, a bathroom and an east bedroom.

The second floor west bedroom had few belongings. A bed was against the south wall and a table with two drawers was against the north wall. A freestanding mirror and furry chair were in the northwest corner of the room. There were a number of apparent bloodstains on the bed, the south wall, the west wall, the door and the floor.

In the third floor east bedroom a bed was against the north wall and a closet was against the south wall. A desk was against the west wall. There were a number of apparent bloodstains on the bed, the north wall, the east wall, the west wall and the door.

FS Barie and Ayers took photographs of the scene using the LizQ Imaging System.

I photographed the scene for overall location, identification and condition.

FS Hogan and Detective Talbott placed markers for all of the stains that were previously labeled and collected by ISP detectives (ISP D2 markers 23-46, 48, 49, 59, and 60). An additional 21 stains were marked by ISPFS (letters B, D-F, H-X) and collected by FS Barie.

FS Hogan performed presumptive tests for the presence of blood on 61 areas from the scene, using Ortho-Tolidine.

Third floor

- west wall of west bedroom (ISP D2 marker 60)

All other stains were Ortho-Tolidine positive, indicating the presence of blood.

The following items were collected from the scene by FS Barie and I: one potential hair from the half wall between floors one and two (marker 5), two potential hairs from the second floor hallway leading to the west bedroom (markers 1 and 2), potential hairs from the second floor west bedroom door (marker 6), one cigarette butt from the exterior of the south side of the residence (marker 3), potential face, hand and finger marks from the exterior south kitchen window (markers 7-9), and one paper note located in the parking area (marker 4).

FS Youngling powder processed the following areas: the exterior lower pane of the south kitchen window, the exterior frame around the lower pane of the south kitchen window, the area around the handle of the exterior and interior of the kitchen sliding glass door, and the frame and jamb of the interior of the kitchen sliding glass door. Six latent lift cards (latents L1 and L2) were collected from the exterior lower pane of the south kitchen window.

I photographed the approximate size and location of bloodstains and/or groups of bloodstains in the second floor west bedroom and the third floor east bedroom. In the second floor west bedroom, bloodstains AA-AG were documented. In the third floor east bedroom, bloodstains BA-BL were documented.

FS Youngling and I processed the following areas with Amido Black: upper handrail between the first and second floor, hallway leading to second floor west bedroom, second floor west bedroom floor, second floor west bedroom door knobs (interior and exterior), threshold of the second floor east bedroom, interior and exterior handle areas of the interior kitchen sliding glass door, door jamb of kitchen sliding glass door, interior threshold of the kitchen sliding glass door, edge of kitchen countertops, half wall railing between the second and third floor, and third floor east bedroom threshold and door knobs (interior and exterior). Latents L3-L6 were collected via photography, from the following: the second floor west bedroom floor (L3), the second floor east bedroom threshold (L4), the edge of the handle from the interior kitchen sliding glass door (L5), and above the handle of the exterior kitchen sliding glass door (L6).

We cleared the scene on 11/18/22 at approximately 2114 PST.

All evidence collected was turned over to Detective Talbott on 11/18/22 at approximately 2241 PST.

We transferred digital images (including LizQ Imaging System captures) to Detective Talbott on 11/19/22 at approximately 0838 PST.

On 11/19/22, at approximately 1113 PST, FS Hogan and I returned to 1122 King Rd. Moscow, Idaho 83843 to photograph potential tire impressions in the road across from the residence, as requested by Detective Talbott.

I took photographs for overall location, condition and identification. I took comparison quality photographs of the potential tire impressions.

We cleared the scene at approximately 1214 PST.

I transferred digital images to Detective Talbott at approximately 1245 PST.

2011 Toyota Prius

On 11/18/22 at approximately 1934 PST, FS Hogan and Barie arrived at 709 W Palouse Dr. Moscow, Idaho 83843 to process a vehicle. They were accompanied by Detective Tolleson (ISP D1). Detective Lehman (ISP D1) and the owner of the vehicle were also present upon their arrival.

The vehicle is a 2011 grey colored Toyota Prius, license plate Idaho 1LG1226, VIN: JTDKN3DU7B5324142. The vehicle was located in a large vehicle bay.

FS Hogan photographed the vehicle for overall location, identification and condition.

FS Hogan and Barie searched the vehicle, but there were no significant findings.

They cleared the scene at approximately 2044 PST.

We transferred digital images to Detective Talbott on 11/19/22 at approximately 0838 PST.

1127 King Rd.

On 11/18/22 at approximately 2117 PST, FS Hogan arrived at 1127 King Rd. Moscow, Idaho 83843, to assist in the search of an apartment. FS Hogan was accompanied by Detective Talbott and Sergeant Van Leuven (ISP D1).

1127 King Rd is an apartment building consisting of two stories. Apartment "1" is located on the ground level and is a multi-bedroom apartment with two bathrooms, a living room and a kitchen. There is a hallway with a kitchen to the north and a living room area to the north of the kitchen. There is at least two bedrooms east of the kitchen. There are two bathrooms south of the kitchen, on the east side of the apartment. The response was limited to the southeast bedroom.

FS Hogan performed two presumptive tests for the presence of blood on the south wall of the entry hallway (marker 1) and on the east wall of the kitchen (marker 2) using Ortho-Tolidine. Positive results, indicating the presence of blood, were obtained on both stains. Swabs were collected from markers 1 and 2 by FS Hogan.

FS Hogan cleared at approximately 2224 PST.

All collected swabs were turned over to Detective Talbott on 11/18/22 at approximately 2241 PST.

We transferred digital images to Detective Talbott on 11/19/22 at approximately 0838 PST.

DISPOSITION:

Digital images are being retained by ISP Forensic Services.

FS Youngling and I uploaded all digital images, excluding those from the LizQ Imaging System, to the digital imaging system on 11/19/22.

On 12/30/22 at approximately 0705 PST, Forensic Scientists (FS) Hailey Youngling, Jennie Ayers and I responded to 1630 NE Valley Rd, #G201, Pullman, Washington to assist in a homicide investigation. Jeffery Talbott with Idaho State Police District 2 (ISP D2) and Dustin Blaker with Moscow Police Department arrived to the residence with us. Deputy Chief Dawn Daniels with Washington State University Police Department (WSU PD) was present upon our arrival. The scene was not secured at this time. The temperature was approximately 33 degrees Fahrenheit and the weather was snowy and wet.

1630 NE Valley Rd #G201 is a beige six-plex apartment building with a maroon/brown colored "G" on the exterior. Apartment #G201 is on the second floor on the east side of the building. The second floor staircase is flush with the surrounding sidewalk and has a single flight of stairs going up. The entryway to apartment #G201 is directly east of the staircase.

The interior of apartment #G201 was well kept and sparsely furnished. There are two bedrooms, one bathroom with a separate water closet, a living room and a kitchen. The entryway door enters to the living room. The living room was furnished with a two-seat sofa on the east wall. There was a coffee table and a rug in front of the sofa. On the west wall, there was a television stand with a television and various books on the interior shelving. In the southwest corner of the living room, there was a disconnected air conditioning type unit. The south wall of the living room has a door that opens to the exterior patio. To the north of the television stand, there was a table with one lamp, powered off. On the north wall of the living room, there is a closet. East of the closet (on the north side of the apartment) are two bedrooms, one on the west side, one on the east side. The northwest bedroom was unfurnished and was locked prior to entry. There are two empty 2-door closets located on the west

wall. The door to the northeast bedroom is in the northwest corner of the room. Along the west wall there was a table that contains a computer tower and electronics. A bed was against the north wall. The east wall contains two 2-door closets. To the south of the closet, there was a stool with folded white towels, a small white trash bin and a white laundry basket. The bathroom is located to the south of the northeast bedroom. The kitchen is located to the south of the bathroom. There was a fridge in the northwest corner of the kitchen. To the east of the fridge is a sink. The stove and oven was on the east wall. There were various kitchen appliances on the counter including a dishrack, an electric can opener, a microwave, coffee makers and a bean grinder. The kitchen cabinets contained various food items, dishes, cooking utensils, pots and pans. On the south wall of the kitchen, there was a table with shelving and one stool.

I photographed the exterior and interior of the apartment for overall location, identification and condition.

FS Ayers captured images using the LizQ Imaging System.

FS Ayers performed presumptive tests for the presence of blood on 51 areas inside the apartment. Positive results, indicating the presence of blood, were obtained on two stains from the bedding of the northeast bedroom. A cutting was collected from a pillow in the northeast bedroom (marker B) and a mattress cover was collected from the bed in the northeast bedroom (marker C). A third stain (marker A) was collected from the kitchen countertop but was not tested, due to the size and condition.

Blood was not detected on twelve stains tested in the kitchen, fifteen stains tested in the northeast bedroom, seventeen stains tested in the bathroom, and five stains tested in the living room.

I collected eleven items from the apartment. I collected five items from the north wall closet: one nitrile type black colored glove (marker 1), one "Walmart" receipt with one "Dickies" tag (marker 2), two "Marshalls" receipts (marker 3), one dust canister from "Bissell PowerForce" vacuum (marker 4), eight possible hair strands from the head of the "Libman" broom (marker 5). I collected one "FireTV" stick with cord and plug from the living room television (marker 6). I collected one possible hair strand from the east wall in the bathroom (marker 8) and one possible hair strand inside the shower drain in the bathroom (marker 9). I collected three items from the northeast bedroom: one possible animal hair strand (marker 7), one possible hair strand from the computer pad in the northeast bedroom (marker 10), and one possible hair strand from a pillow in the northeast bedroom (marker 11). FS Ayers collected one computer tower in the northeast bedroom (marker 12).

We cleared the scene at approximately 1933 PST.

All evidence was turned over to Deputy Chief Daniels at approximately 2022 PST on 12/30/22.
