PROFESSIONAL MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

Category:

The Professional category of membership includes college/university graduates not previously initiated into Alpha Phi Sigma.

Eligibility

Professionals shall have made a distinctive contribution to the profession; shall have earned a Baccalaureate degree in criminal justice or related field from a regionally accredited institution; working in the profession as a criminal justice practitioner for a minimum of two (2) years; shall have a minimum cumulative 3.2 GPA on a 4.0 scale as undergraduate student or minimum cumulative 3.4 GPA on a 4.0 scale as graduate student. Academic transcript and personal resume must accompany the application. Membership application packet must be submitted to Headquarters and approved by the Executive Director.

Acceptance of Professional Member:

Membership in Alpha Phi Sigma is open to qualified candidates including persons with disability, without regard to age, color, gender, race, creed, national origin, race, religion, and/or sexual orientation.

PROCEDURES:

Recruitment:

The potential Professional member may apply for membership by submitting the application, required documentation, and fee to Headquarters. The application shall be reviewed by Headquarters to determine if the minimum criteria have been met. Chapters (Collegiate and Alumni) are encouraged to establish a procedure for recruiting Professional Members.

Fees

There is a one-time fee of \$400.00 to become a Professional Member.

Initiation:

The Alpha Phi Sigma Initiation ceremony shall be a written oath. If in close proximity of a chapter, the candidate may be initiated with a chapter.

Membership:

Upon the approval of membership, the professional member will receive an Alpha Phi Sigma certificate of membership, wallet card, polo t-shirt, specialty pen, and anniversary pin and coin.
