



# What is an ESD?

## About our Provider

Atascosa County Emergency Services District No. 1 has a Service Provider Contract with the Lytle Volunteer Fire Department to provide both fire protection and first responder services for ACESD 1.

The Lytle Volunteer Fire Department has been in service since 1955. They have two stations, and 8 apparatuses. The department is a combination department having both part time firefighters and volunteers.

ACESD 1 Commissioners meet monthly with the service provider to review and take action on services provided to the residences within the ACESD 1 boundaries.



# What is an ESD?

Emergency Services Districts (ESDs) are authorized by the Texas Constitution, Article 3, Section 48-e, and Chapter 775 of the Texas Health & Safety Code. ESDs are political subdivisions of the State of Texas. They may support or provide local emergency services, including emergency medical services, emergency ambulance services, rural fire prevention and control services, and other emergency services authorized by the Texas Legislature. ESDs may collect a sales and use tax and/or property taxes to support or provide these services.

Atascosa County Emergency Services District No. 1 (ACESD 1) is a political subdivision of the State of Texas serving as a taxing district to support emergency services.

Atascosa County Emergency Services District No. 1 was formed in 2020. The district protects and serves an estimated 5,000 residents who live and work within the 25 square miles District boundaries, serving the northwest portion of Atascosa County.

Atascosa County ESD 1 is governed by a board of five Commissioners. Your ACESD 1 Commissioners are:
