MINUTES

REGULAR MEETING

ATASCOSA COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 1 October 18, 2022

The Board of Commissioners of Atascosa County Emergency Services District No. 1 conducted a Regular Meeting at 15078 Main Street, Lytle, TX 78052 on October 18, 2022 at 6:00 PM.

1) Call the Atascosa County Emergency Services District 1 meeting to order and establish a quorum.

Meeting was called to order at 6:01 pm and a quorum was established. Board members in attendance were Lee Redoux, Nikki Fuentes, Tommy Krisch, David Reeh, and Kenneth Steffens.

- 2) Invocation: Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag. *Pledge recited.*
- 3) Citizens to be heard: This item will be open for a maximum of 30 minutes with 3 minutes per speaker. (If there are more than 10 speakers, each will be given 2 minutes.)

- 4) Consent items:

 Commissioner Fuentes moved to accept the consent agenda items as presented.

The Board reviewed the written reports which showed a total of 14 incidents responded to within Atascosa County with an average response time of 8.37 minutes. Chief Garcia reported that the department was working towards a staffing of 3 personnel per day and that Lytle VFD had received a Texas Forest Service Grant for \$20,000 for the purchase of PPE.
