DOCUMENTS/FORMS

REGISTRATION

Fall Registration will be open until August 24, 2024 or until rosters are full whichever comes first. (Late fees are assessed after June 1)

NO EXPERIENCE IS REQUIRED

COSTS

Fall Registration Fees: Due June 1

Football- \$250(6u & 12u \$175)

Cheer- \$325

***\$25 late fees will be assessed after due date**

All Football and Cheer participants will need to turn in a birth certificate.

All 12u Football participants must attend the league onsite registration Saturday, 7/26/25, time/location TBD. 12u participants will need to turn in a state ID or passport. Meanwhile, if they turn in a birth certificate, one of the parents that are listed on the birth certificate must attend the registration with an ID.

***You are required to submit your birth certificate by July 17!**

You will not receive your uniform unless you have paid in full.

UNIFORMS

Each tackle football player must have the following required equipment:

1. Football practice pants with appropriate padding (*)
2. Football cleats(prefer same color) – NO METAL CLEATS (*)
3. Mouthpiece (one will be provided; replacement will cost \$1)
4. Shoulder Pads(+)
5. Helmet(+)
6. Game Jersey
7. Game Pants
8. Practice Jersey*)
9. There must be uniformity at all times. (including socks & helmets)

Each cheerleader must have the following required equipment:

1. Comfortable sneakers & "no show" socks for practice (*)
2. Cheerleading Shoes (determined by Cheer Director)(*)
3. Game Uniform
4. Pom-poms(+)
5. There must be uniformity at all times.
6. Cheer Coaches may make any additional items mandatory for their team.

ABSENCES

VOLUNTEERING

Each person who registers a child with the Rosenberg Panthers (football/cheerleaders) is expected to volunteer and work duty shifts during HOME games. Each person will be fined or will have their child's participation suspended for failing to work a duty shift. Each family is required to work 2 hours or buy out for \$50.00. \$50.00 must be paid before the season starts beginning in September. Your child cannot participate until it's paid. Once the season starts, you cannot buy out; you must work a 2 hour shift. There will be no exceptions to this rule.
