The Grey Area

THE GREY AREA is a show organized by ...On The Same Page Artists' Book Collective, where a team of 16 artists from across the country of varied backgrounds have come together to display their artists' books, all on the singular theme of "Conflicts".

We live in a world that is increasingly getting polarized by absolutes. Inevitably, conflicts brew and clarity dissolves across these absolutes; the conflicts that ensue have been created through the lines of demarcations across societies that are divided by needs, wants, beliefs, ideologies and identities. At its core, the exhibition challenges the notion of separation by highlighting the varied contradictions deep-rooted in all the shades between the extremes.

Each of the artists' books on display is a dialogue about THE GREY AREA that exists between the extremes. From war-torn memories to personal reckonings, the show challenges the viewer to question the binaries and the extremes, and to acknowledge the uncomfortable murkiness of the unresolved. The artworks do not offer solutions—they offer mirrors.

While often viewed negatively, conflict can also be a catalyst for change, prompting dialogue, innovation, and social transformation when managed constructively.

দ্য গ্রে এরিয়া

‘দ্য গ্রে এরিয়া’- এমন প্রদর্শনী পরিকল্পনার সূচর্থৰ ‘On The Same Page Artists' Book Collective’. যেখানে সারা দেশের ভিন্ন ভিন্ন ভাবনায় চালিত ১৫ জন শিল্পীর কাজকে একত্রিত করা হয়েছে। শিল্পীরা প্রত্যেকেই পৃথক ভাবনায় চালিত হলেও প্রদর্শনীর পরিকল্পনা অনুযায়ী একটি সাধারণ বিষয়কে ভাবনার কেন্দ্রে রেখে তারা তৈরি করেছেন নিজেদের artist's book. কেন্দ্রীয় ভাবনার প্রধান সূচক- ‘সংঘাত’।

আমরা এখন এমন এক পৃথিবীতে বাস করি যেখানে সবকিছু ক্রমেই একটা মেরুকরণ নির্ভর চরম সীমায় পৌঁছে যাচ্ছে। তখনই এই চূড়ান্ত মেরুকরণ পদ্ধা নিজের চলনেই তৈরি করে দিচ্ছে নানা ধরণের সংঘাত। এই সংঘাত আবার ভাবনার স্পষ্টতাকে আবছা করে দিচ্ছে দিনের পর দিন। তাই ক্রমবর্ধমান চলতে থাকা এই মেরু নির্ভর সংঘাতগুলো আজকের সমাজে বিবিধ টানাপোড়েনের মাঝে বিভাজন রেখা টেনে দিয়েছে— চাহিদা, আকাঙ্ক্ষা, বিশ্বাস, মতবাদ আর পরিচয়ের নানা ভিন্নতাতেই সেই বিভাজন আজ স্পষ্ট। প্রদর্শনীর মূল ভাবনা এই বিভাজনকেই প্রশংসন করা, এবং দেখানো যে চরম দুই প্রান্তের বা মেরুর মাঝখানে কত অগণিত বৈপর্যাত্য ও দ্বন্দ্ব লুকিয়ে আছে।

প্রদর্শনীর প্রতিটি শিল্পগুলু সেদিক থেকে আসলেই একেকটি আলাপচারিতা— যেখানে শিল্পীরা দেখাচ্ছেন চরম পদ্ধার মাঝের অস্পষ্ট ধূসর অঞ্চল বা দ্য গ্রে এরিয়া। যুদ্ধবিধ্বস্ত স্মৃতি থেকে শুরু করে ব্যক্তিগত টানাপোড়েন— সবই উঠে এসেছে এই শিল্পকর্মে। দর্শককে এখানে কোনো সমাধান দেওয়া হয়নি; বরং তাকে হাজির করা হয়েছে এমন এক আয়নার সামনে যেখানে সে নিজেই তার প্রশ্নের মুখোমুখি হতে পারে।

তাই এই প্রদর্শনী বলতে চায় সংঘাতকে আমরা প্রায়শই নেতৃবাচকভাবে দেখি। অথচ অনেক সময় এই সংঘাতই পরিবর্তনের অনুষ্টক হয়ে ওঠে— আলোচনার জন্ম দেয়, নতুন ভাবনার পথ খুলে দেয়, আর সমাজকে এগিয়ে নিয়ে যায় গঠনমূলক কার্যকরের পথে।

Visual Artist & Printmaker

Amritah Sen did her graduation and post-graduation with Painting specialization from Kala Bhavana, Visva Bharati University, Shantiniketan, India. Though specialized as a painter, eventually she has extended her practice into Book Art, Paper Toys, graphic narratives and videos.

As an artist, Amritah is obsessive about stories. For long she has been curious about people's stories, and narrative that create the larger parallel history beside its main course. This led her to study the flowing history, changing cultural aspects of the place where she belongs, that is Bengal. In last one decade she has participated in several projects that investigates deep into the history of Bengal and its people. This curiosity made her work in collaboration with different art Residencies in Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Nepal and Pakistan, and of course within India.

Amritah has shown her works frequently in group shows in different venues in India, South Asia, Europe and USA. She has done ten solo shows till date and numerous group shows across India and abroad. She has co-curated group shows bringing South Asian artist together in a platform with Kurchi Dasgupta in Ganges Art Gallery, Kolkata (2017, 2018).

Bikash Acharjee has been practicing print making and other mediums for the last two decades. His works have been exhibited in many major shows across India and the world.




Dr. ANIRBAN DHAR

He has published more than 20 article/paper Journals and more than 5 Chapters in Book on printmaking in peer-reviewed and UGC-listed journals.



Visual Artist & Educator





MUNINDRA NARAYAN BHATTACHARYYA


Artist, Poet & Academician




