COURSE EXAMPLES

COURSE	DESCRIPTION
Adversary Tactics	Provides Adversary Tactics specifically tailored to client threats, which are utilized to evaluate security strategies, equipment and training.
Active Attacker & Rapid Deployment	Provides specific methods/strategies to security forces, based on their environment, to allow them to defend/counter active attacker(s) situations.
Airport Security	Provides comprehensive training for divisions including ID and passport control, weapons and explosive detection and control, immigration, drug prevention, customs and all aspects of security personnel.
Casualty Collection & Management	Provides instruction on mass casualty collection points, managing resources and allocation of support staff during emergency situations.
Close-Quarter Combat (CBQ) & Dynamic Clearing	Provides education on the methodical clearing of structures/locations, while countering threats of lethal adversaries. (i.e. client may be required to defend vital infrastructures to prevent theft, sabotage of material or safeguard life/property).



COURSE EXAMPLES

COURSE	DESCRIPTION
Explosion Detections & Early Intervention	Provides training to assist security forces and/or civilian staff with the identification of suspicious package(s) and early intervention strategies to prevent loss of life and/or damage to infrastructure.
Less Lethal Munitions	Provides consultation, knowledge and strategies to assist in the development/use of a client's Less Lethal measures for countering threats.
Light Armored Vehicle Defensive Tactics & Casualty Care	Provides Light Armoured Vehicle (LAV) operators with the basic knowledge and skills required to medically support team members and tactically plan, detect, and defend from adversaries.
Oil Pipeline Security and Defence	Provides training in pipeline security, vessel and platform security, anti-piracy and drone support.
Port Security	Training for security personnel and law enforcement, drug, weapon and explosive detection, utilization of CCTV and drone support.
Self-Defense	Utilized to develop/refine security forces; this course is specifically focused on the control of threats through self-defense skills such as: strategic positioning, empty hand control techniques and strikes/joint locks with weapon retention.



COURSE EXAMPLES

COURSE	DESCRIPTION
Tactical Combat Casualty Care (TCCC)	Provides the basic knowledge and skills necessary to help sustain life and minimize the consequences of severe trauma, while working in an austere and/or tactical environment; prior to arrival of Paramedics or non-Tactical Emergency Medical Responder.
Very Important Person or Property (VIP/P) Transport	Provides strategy development and training for the clients required to to support the protection of person(s) or property during transit.
Use of Force Training	Utilized to develop/refine security forces; learn to articulate/control threats through self-defense skills, less lethal options (i.e. OC Spray, Baton) or lethal force options.
