

OFF-LEASH CLUB RULES & REGULATIONS
(must be signed & dated with payment)

To ensure the health and safety of your dog and our other Snoqualmie River Off Leash Park guests, there are certain requirements that you and your dog must meet:

All dogs must be non-aggressive or toy protective. As owner, you know best how your dog behaves with other dogs, It is a must that your dog(s) can get along with others. We appreciate your honesty.

All dogs must be at least four months old.

All male dogs over nine months old must be neutered. Females that are not spayed may not attend the offleash area while in heat.

All dogs must have up-to-date vaccinations. Owners must submit written proof of Rabies, DHLPP and Bordetella vaccinations. "DHLPP" or the "5-in-1" shot are Distemper, Hepatitis, Leptospirosis, Parainfluenza and Parvovirus. A "6-in-1" shot could include the Bordetella (kennel cough) vaccine or it may require a separate inoculation. (It is the member's responsibility to keep vaccines up-to-date.)

Dogs that do not take traditional shots and are under the care of a natural homeopathic veterinarian are welcome at Snoqualmie River Off Leash Park but will require a written note from their vet.

All dogs must be in good health. For the safety of all members' dogs, if your dog is contagious or has been ill, please talk to you vet before returning to the Off-Leash Area.

Members understand that there is still a possibility of dog-related illnesses occurring from the use of the Snoqualmie River Off Leash Park .

The health and safety of you and your dog(s) are our main concern. However, participating in Snoqualmie River Off Leash Park does involve the possible risk of injury to you, other people, your dog(s), and other dogs.

Snoqualmie River Off Leash Park makes no claims that the park is secure. For this reason, your dog must have recall. Snoqualmie River Off Leash Park takes no responsibility if your dog gets out of the park.

Due to possible legal actions, Snoqualmie River Off Leash Park and the owner of the property cannot take responsibility for any such injuries or illnesses. Members will be required to sign a legal disclosure releasing them of any legal responsibility.

Snoqualmie River Off Leash Park highly recommends your dog(s) be on a flea treatment program however if your dog(s) are not we cannot take responsibility for them contracting fleas.

Members and guests must obey all the following rules at Snoqualmie River Off Leash Park: Please make a copy of the rules.

1. There is a three-dog limit per member.
2. Members can walk other member's dogs with Snoqualmie River Off Leash Park permission, but cannot walk more than 3 dogs at a time.
3. Dogs must have recall.
4. Use plastic bags to clean up after your dog.
5. Keep your dog from digging holes.
6. Stop bothersome dog behavior immediately.
7. Leave your dog(s) in your vehicle until parked.
8. Park in the designated gravel parking area.
9. Observe the 5 mph speed limit.
10. Be aware of dogs at the gate and do not let dogs escape when entering or leaving the area.
11. Close all gates behind you.
