Visiting Universal Studios (Orlando, Hollywood, or abroad) is an exciting, action-packed experience with immersive attractions, 3D rides, and themed areas. Planning ahead ensures you enjoy your day to the fullest without unnecessary interruptions.



Essential items for a seamless and enjoyable theme park experience

1. Entry & Planning Essentials

- Park admission ticket or digital pass
- Express Pass (if purchased separately for reduced wait times)
- Government-issued photo ID
- Credit/debit card or preloaded gift card
- Universal Orlando/Hollywood mobile app (for ride wait times, maps, virtual line access, mobile food orders)
- Parking confirmation or directions to designated transportation area

2. Personal Essentials

- Comfortable, weather-appropriate clothing
- Supportive, closed-toe walking shoes
- Sunglasses and hat or cap
- Lightweight rain poncho (frequent afternoon showers in Orlando)
- Sunscreen (travel size, broad-spectrum SPF)
- Lip balm with SPF
- Reusable water bottle (refill stations are available)
- Small backpack or sling bag (note: lockers required for some thrill rides)

3. Technology & Park Convenience

- Fully charged phone
- Portable power bank and charging cable
- Waterproof phone pouch or case
- External battery case (optional)
- Digital or printed ride reservation/virtual line confirmations
- Park map (available digitally via the app)

4. Snacks & Dining

- Non-perishable snacks (Universal permits small snacks)
- Dining reservation confirmations (for full-service restaurants)
- Refillable souvenir cup (if participating in Coke Freestyle program)
- Napkins, wet wipes, or tissues

5. Optional Enhancements

- Motion sickness remedies (some rides are highly immersive or intense)
- Cooling towel or portable fan (summer months)
- Zip-lock bags (for water rides or wet items)
- Reusable straw (many parks are straw-free)
- Autograph book and pen (for character meet-and-greets)
- Harry Potter wand (for interactive experiences in Wizarding World)

6. Family & Child-Specific Items

- Stroller (if bringing young children — check park size guidelines)
- Diapers, wipes, and changing supplies
- Baby formula, bottles, and bibs
- Child-safe sunscreen and hats
- Identification wristbands or emergency contact cards for children
- Favorite comfort item or small toy
- Spare clothing or swimwear (for water play areas)

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
