
McKitrick Cares

Be Ready for those BACK-TO-SCHOOL

Balanced Breakfasts!



Making breakfast in the morning before school can be a chore, but we all know how important the first meal of the day can be. Breakfast jump starts our metabolism and gets our brain working so that learning is a little easier. Here are some easy quick healthy breakfast meals to get your child going in the morning without the time it can take to make a well-balanced meal.

10 Quick and Healthy Breakfast Options

Yogurt, granola, berries: good brands of yogurt that kids seem to like are Nosa, Stoneyfield, Chobani Nut butter on toast with a side of fruit and hard-boiled egg

Whole grain waffles with fruit and either yogurt or egg

Bagel with cream cheese and fruit

Whole grain low sugar cereal (<11g of sugar/serving) with low fat/fat free milk, fruit

Protein bar with yogurt: kid friendly ideas: Lara bar, z-bar, whole grain fig bar, whole grain fruit bar Eggs, English muffin or mini bagel, fruit

Cheese stick, nuts, dried fruit

Smoothie with yogurt, fruit, and vegetable such as carrots, spinach or kale

Oatmeal with dried fruit or fresh fruit, honey or brown sugar (sprinkle for flavor 1tsp or less)

HOMEMADE PROTEIN BAR IDEA:

No Bake Granola Bars: good option to make over the weekend and have on hand throughout the week.

Ingredients

- 3/4 cup creamy nut butter (peanut, almond, sunflower...)
- ½ cup honey
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 2 cups quick oats
- 1 cup krispie cereal
- Toppings: raisins, craisins, cinnamon, dehydrated fruit, trail mix, pretzels, peanut butter chips, butterscotch chips, or M&M's

Directions

Line the baking sheet with aluminum foil, wax paper or parchment paper

Mix oats and rice krispies together in a bowl

In a microwave safe bowl, mix together nut butter and honey. Microwave for 30 second intervals until melted. Stir together until mixed

Stir in the vanilla to the peanut butter mix

Pour the peanut butter and honey mixture into the oat and rice krispie mixture. Fold over until well incorporated

Add the toppings you prefer and mix

Once mixed, press your granola mixture into the foil lined pan

Top with any extra toppings, pressing them into the granola

Place in the refrigerator for 3-4 hours or until fully set. Slice into bar shapes and enjoy.
