
MCKITRICK ALL PRO DADS!

Below are some useful suggestions for staying physically, emotionally, and mentally healthy during stressful times. We hope this information provides you with useful ideas that you can adopt for your family.

Keep Physically Active

Going for a walk, riding your bike, exercising in general will boost your immune system, improve your mood, and reduce anxiety levels. Children need to be active at least 60 minutes every day. You can stay active at home with your family by dancing, swimming, doing yoga or other routines (some activities can even be found online). Gardening and housework are also good ways to stay active.

Create A Routine

Map out a routine for you and your child that includes time for learning, meals, exercise, relaxation, play, and bedtime. Schedule creative activities such as arts and crafts, reading, music, etc. Make sure you take regular breaks and minimize distractions by working and studying in a separate space. Limit screen time especially before bedtime. You

Eat Healthy Food

Eating a healthy, balanced diet will strengthen your immune system and boost your mood. Eat a variety of foods such as vegetables, starchy foods (pasta, rice, potatoes), and proteins such as beans, fish, eggs, and meat. Stay hydrated and eat healthy snacks such as yogurt, fruits, vegetables, hummus, plain crackers, plain popcorn, and rice cakes. Limit sugary snacks that can cause tooth decay, poor concentration, and weight gain.

Look After Your Mental Health

Monitor how much you listen to the news if it makes you anxious. Stay socially connected with friends and family. Make space in your life for 'time-in' - an opportunity to reflect on the inner nature of our mental life and bodily sensations. Practice mindfulness or meditation on a regular basis. You Tube is a good resource for guided practices. Also, check out mental health apps like HEADSPACE, PACIFICA, CALM, and MINDFULNESS. Be present for others and show compassion and kindness. Keeping a gratitude journal is another way to keep you mentally healthy and balanced. Practice 'focus time' - doing one thing at a time to help your brain grow and make new connections.

Rest and Refresh

Get plenty of sleep. Go to bed at a regular time each day and practice good habits to get better sleep. Sleep restores both your mind and body. Allow yourself some unfocussed time each day to refresh, let your mind wander, go daydream. It's okay to add 'do nothing' to your to-do list!
